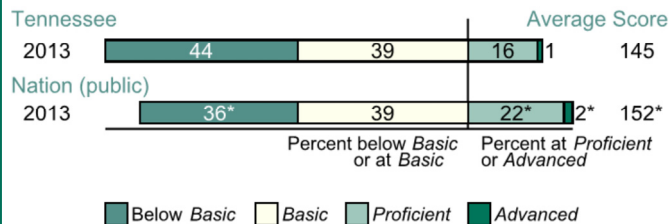


**Overall Results**

- In 2013, the average score of twelfth-grade students in Tennessee was 145. This was lower than the average score of 152 for public school students in the nation.
- The percentage of students in Tennessee who performed at or above the NAEP *Proficient* level was 17 percent in 2013. This percentage was smaller than the nation (25 percent).
- The percentage of students in Tennessee who performed at or above the NAEP *Basic* level was 56 percent in 2013. This percentage was smaller than the nation (64 percent).

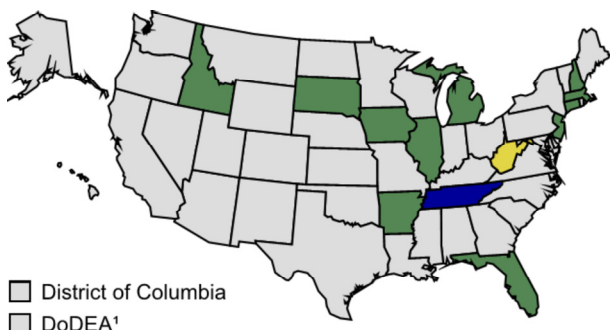
**Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results**

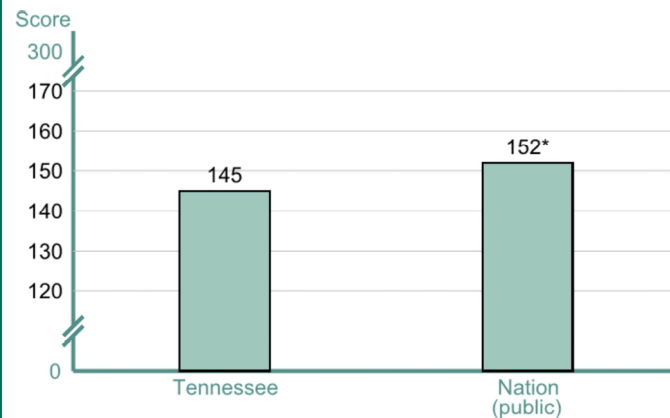
**Compare the Average Score in 2013 to Other States/Jurisdictions**

- In 2013, the average score in **Tennessee** (145) was
- lower than those in 11 states/jurisdictions
  - higher than those in 0 states/jurisdictions
  - not significantly different from that in 1 state/jurisdiction

**Score Gaps for Student Groups**

- In 2013, Black students had an average score that was 27 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from the nation (29 points).
- In 2013, Hispanic students had an average score that was 22 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from the nation (21 points).
- In 2013, male students in Tennessee had an average score that was higher than female students by 4 points.
