

Overall Results

- In 2013, the average score of twelfth-grade students in New Jersey was 292. This was higher than the average score of 287 for public school students in the nation.
- The average score for students in New Jersey in 2013 (292) was not significantly different from their average score in 2009 (288).
- The score gap between higher performing students in New Jersey (those at the 75th percentile) and lower performing students (those at the 25th percentile) was 49 points in 2013. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (53 points).
- The percentage of students in New Jersey who performed at or above the NAEP Proficient level was 41 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (39 percent).
- The percentage of students in New Jersey who performed at or above the NAEP Basic level was 77 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (74 percent).



Compare the Average Score in 2013 to Other States/Jurisdictions



Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2013, Black students had an average score that was 30 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (28 points).
- In 2013, Hispanic students had an average score that was 25 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (22 points).
- In 2013, female students in New Jersey had an average score that was higher than male students by 9 points.
