Subject: INFORMATION: 2013 Advanced Placement Exam Participation and Performance for Students in Montgomery County Public Schools, and Public School Students in the State of Maryland and the Nation

The continuing emphasis by Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) on rigorous course taking resulted in MCPS students taking a record-setting 33,642 Advanced Placement (AP) exams in 2013 (Table 1). Additionally, the percentage of AP exams taken by MCPS students who attained scores of 3 or higher (73.0%) was 12.6 and 16.0 percentage points higher than those for public school students in the state of Maryland (60.4%) and the nation (57.0%), respectively. Generally, the number of AP exams taken by MCPS students in 2013 accounted for 31.1 percent of all those taken by Maryland public school students, and the number of AP exams with scores of 3 or higher taken by MCPS students accounted for 37.6 percent of all those in Maryland.

MCPS students of all races/ethnicities set records for the number of AP exams who earned scores of 3 or higher compared with their peers in the state and the nation. Particularly noteworthy was the percentage of AP exams taken by MCPS Black or African American students that achieved scores of 3 or higher (47.0%), which was 15.9 and 18.8 percentage points higher than those in the state (31.1%) and the nation (28.2%), respectively (Table 1). Overall, the number of AP exams taken by MCPS Black or African American students with scores of 3 or higher accounted for 28.4 percent of all those in Maryland in 2013.

Spanning the three recent school years, there was a small increase in attaining AP exam scores of 3 or higher by MCPS students (71.8% to 73.0%), and public school students in the state of Maryland (59.0% to 60.4%) and the nation (55.8% to 57.0%) (Table 2). The same pattern of AP exam performance was seen for all racial/ethnic groups in the district, and across the state and the nation. A notable increase, 3.4 percentage points, was observed for MCPS students who identified themselves as Two or More Races.

Between 2012 and 2013, the percentage of AP exams taken by public school students in the district, the state, and the nation who earned a score of 3 or higher decreased 2.0, 1.0, and 0.3 percentage points, respectively (Table 2). A similar trend was found in regard to the AP exams taken by students of all racial/ethnic groups except MCPS students who identified themselves as Two or More Races (1 percentage point increase) and public school Black or African American students in Maryland (0.2 percentage point increase) and the nation (0.5 percentage point increase). The largest decrease, 4.8 percentage points, was observed for MCPS Black or African American students.

MCPS high schools continued to support AP exam participation and performance of minority students. Between 2012 and 2013, 14 out of the 25 high schools showed an increase in the number of AP exams taken by Black or African American students, and 18 out of the 25 high schools showed an increase in the number of AP exams taken by Hispanic/Latino students (Tables A2a and A2b). Eight out of the 25 high schools showed an increase in the percentage of AP exams taken by Black or African American students who earned scores of 3 or higher, and 9 out of the 25 high schools showed an increase in the percentage of AP exams taken by Hispanic/Latino students who earned

scores of 3 or higher. Three of the 25 high schools showed increases for both AP exam participation and performance for Black or African American students; of those, Wheaton High School showed the greatest improvement (8.5 percentage points) in these students earning AP exam scores of 3 or higher. Seven of the 25 high schools showed increases for both AP exam participation and performance for Hispanic/Latino students; out of seven schools, Col. Zadok Magruder High School showed the largest increase (12.7 percentage points) in these students attaining AP exam scores of 3 or higher.

In 2013, the 20 AP exams taken most frequently by students in MCPS were: U.S. Government and Politics, English Language and Composition, Psychology, World History, English Literature and Composition, U.S. History, Calculus AB, Statistics, Biology, Environmental Science, Calculus BC, Spanish Language, Chemistry, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Physics C: Mechanics, Human Geography, Computer Science A, Government and Politics: Comparative, and European History (Table B1).

Noteworthy gains were found in both the number of exams taken and the percentage of AP exam scores of 3 or higher in Chemistry, Macroeconomics, and Computer Science A for students overall and for at least four racial/ethnic groups from 2012 to 2013 (Table B2). There was an increase in the number of exams taken and the percentage of AP exam scores of 3 or higher in Chemistry, Physics C: Mechanics, Government and Politics: Comparative, and U.S. History for Black or African American students. An increase was evident for Hispanic/Latino students in the number of exams taken and the percentage of AP exam scores of 3 or higher in Biology, Chemistry, Macroeconomics, Psychology, and Computer Science A.

The positive trends in AP exam participation and performance provide evidence of MCPS' continuing efforts to ensure inclusive and challenging curricular opportunities for students of all races/ethnicities and to prepare all students for college-level work. The attached tables provide additional AP exam information for your review. Tables A1 through A6 provide data on exam taking and performance among groups of students enrolled in MCPS schools, and public school students in Maryland and the nation. Tables B1 through B22 provide 2013 AP data for student groups and high school participation and performance by subject.


