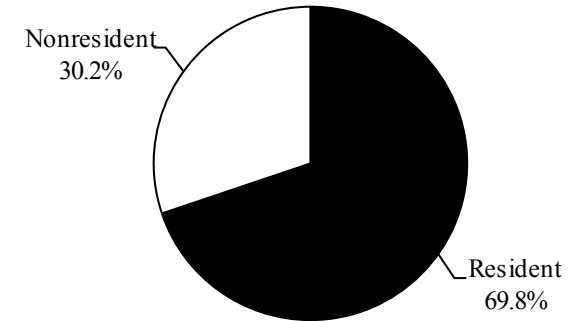
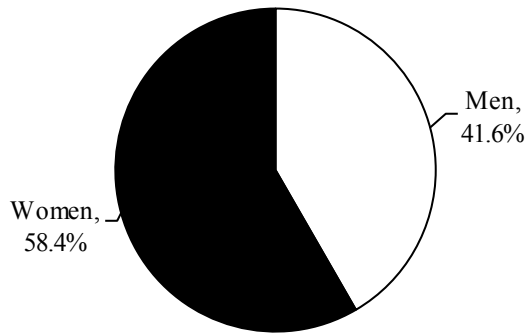
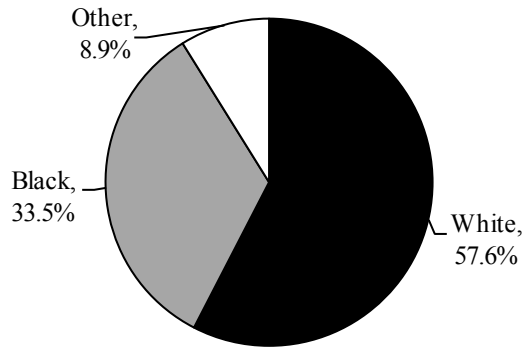
**Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment**

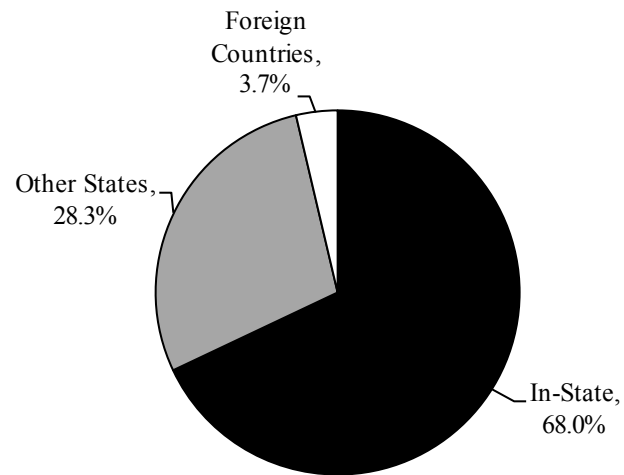

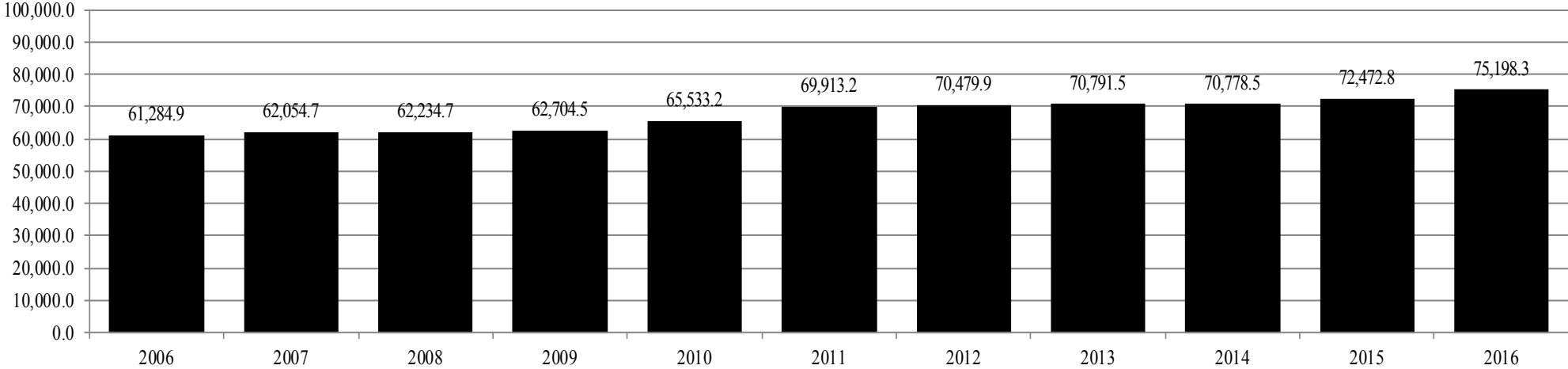

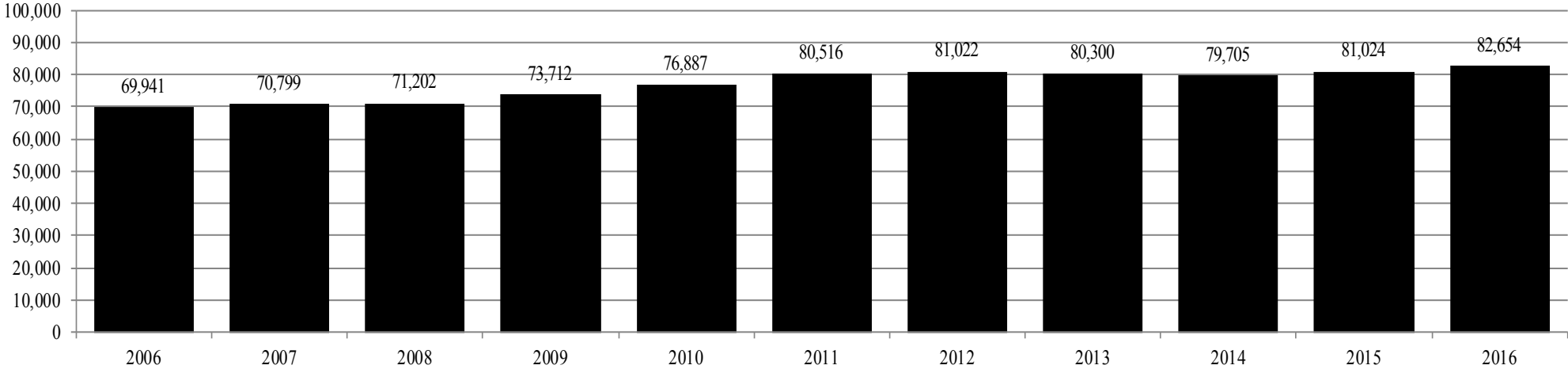

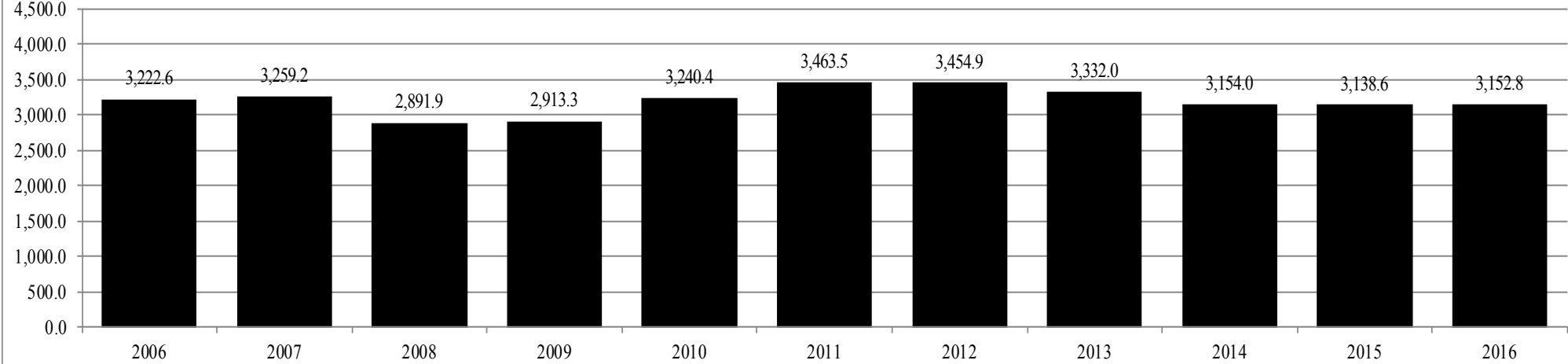

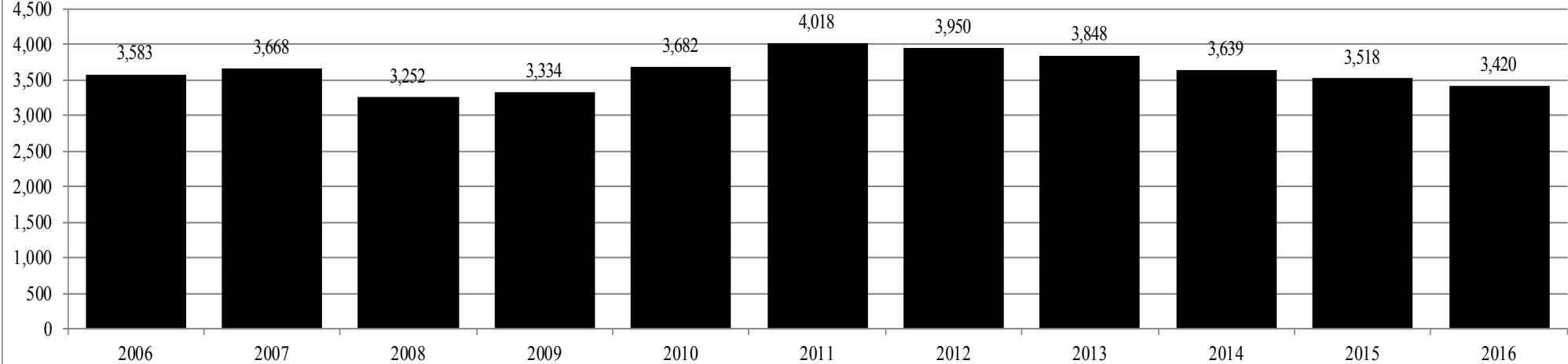


**ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY TOTAL FTE AND TOTAL HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT**

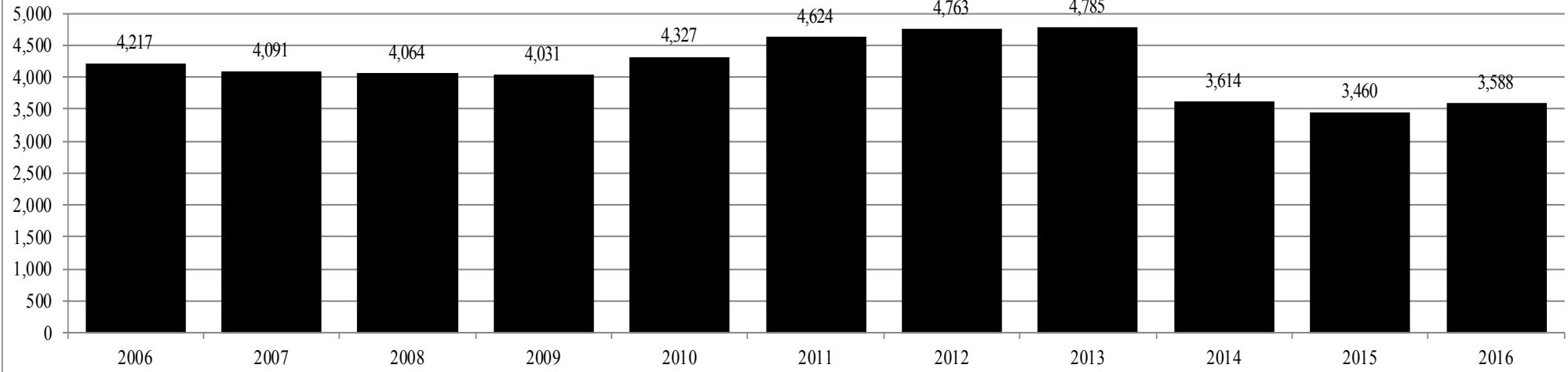

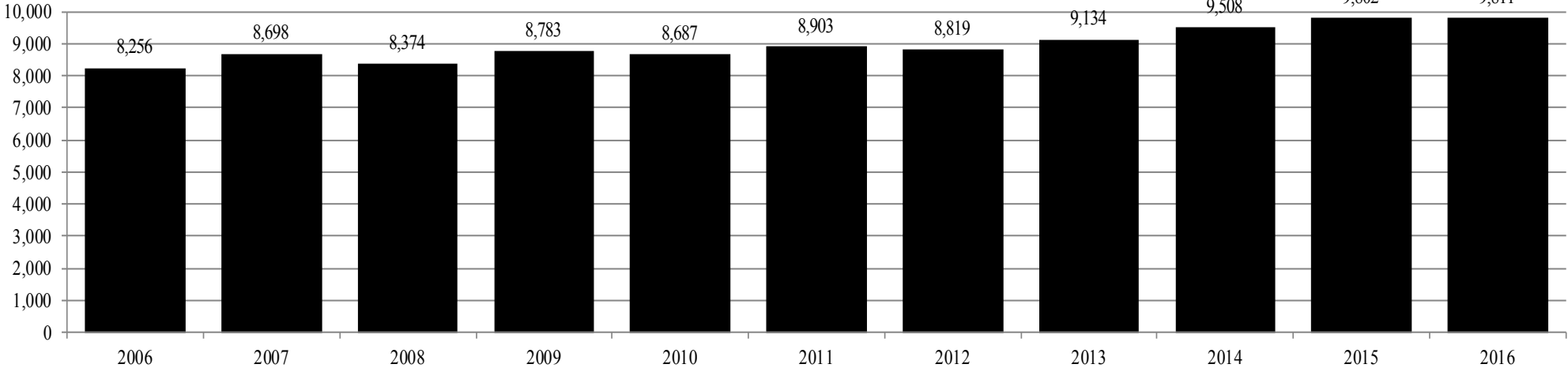

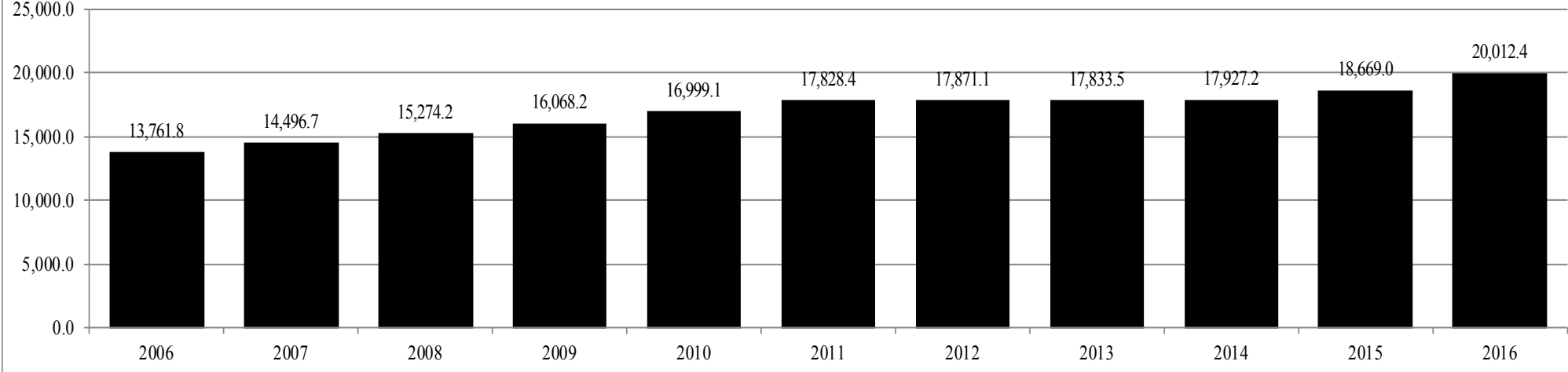

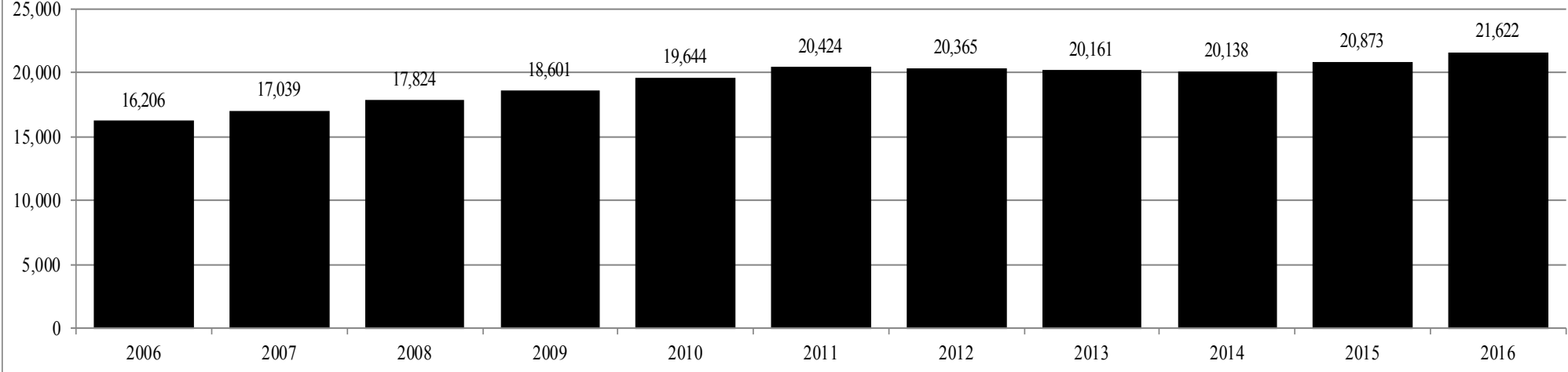

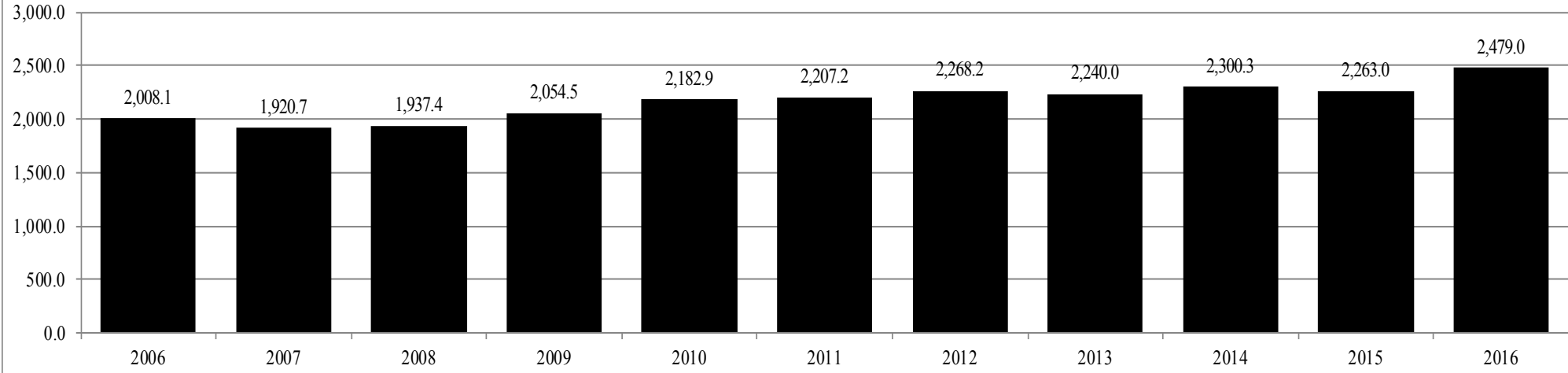

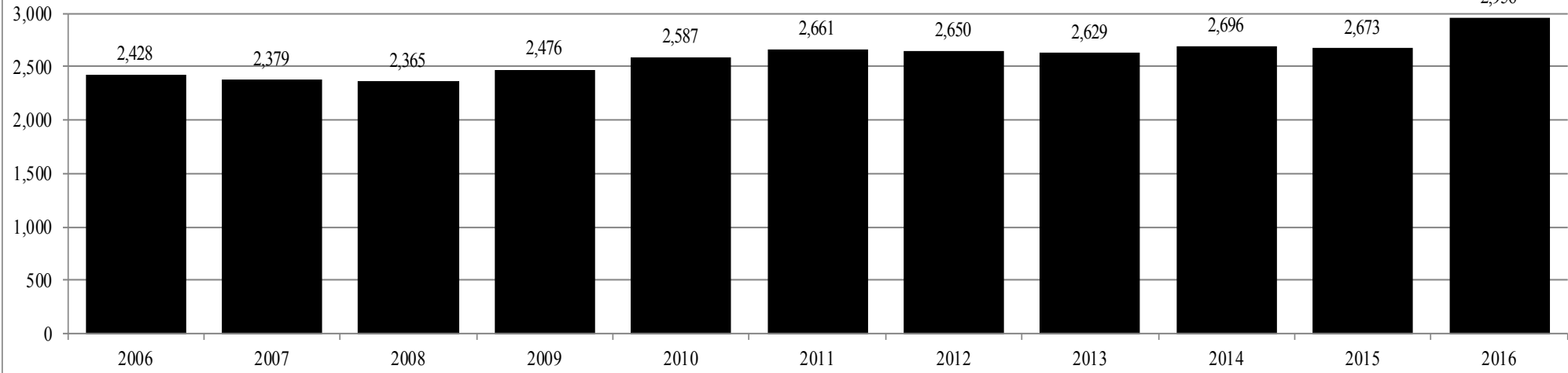


**MISSISSIPPI UNIVERSITY FOR WOMEN TOTAL FTE AND TOTAL HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT**

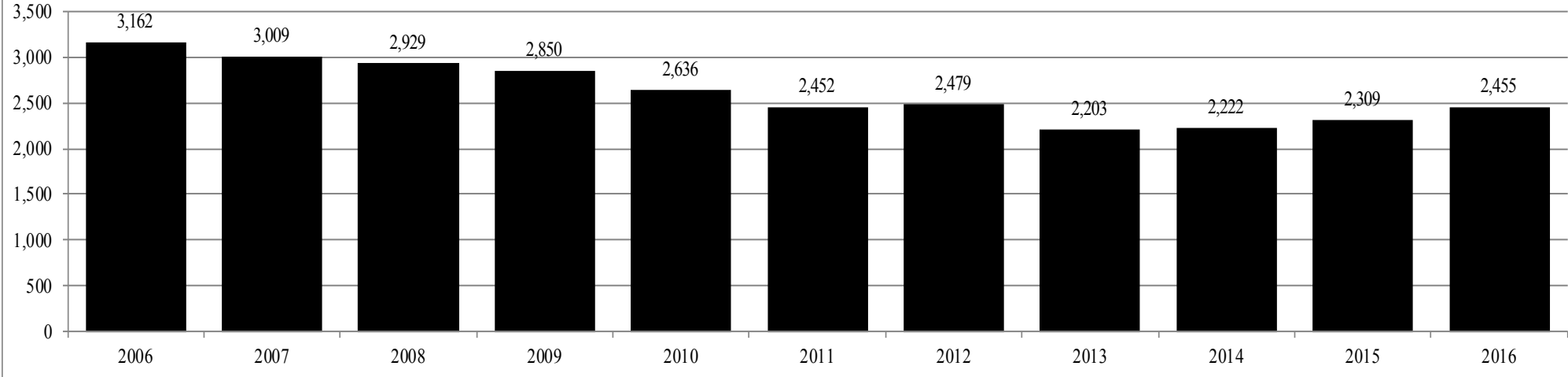

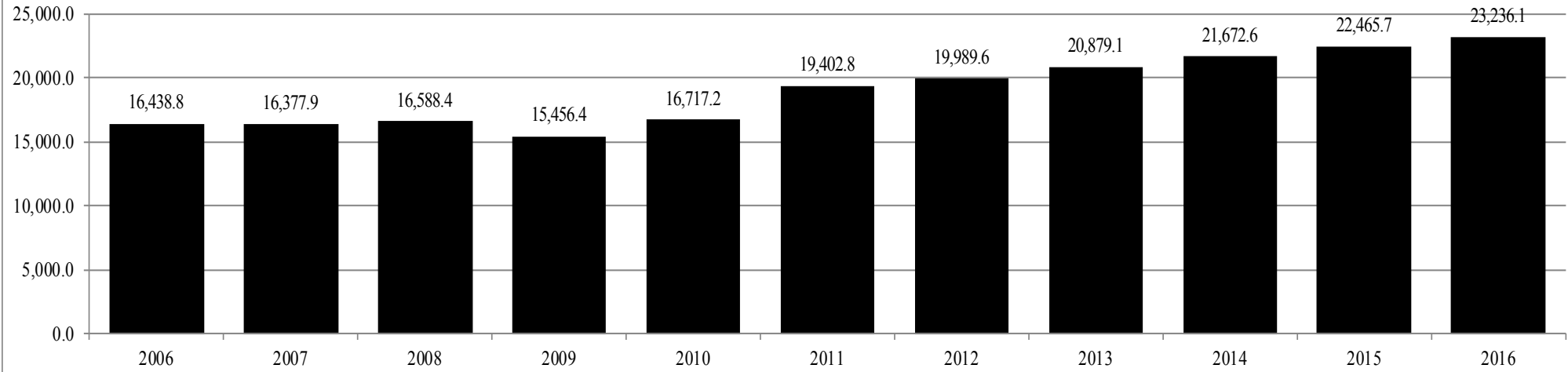

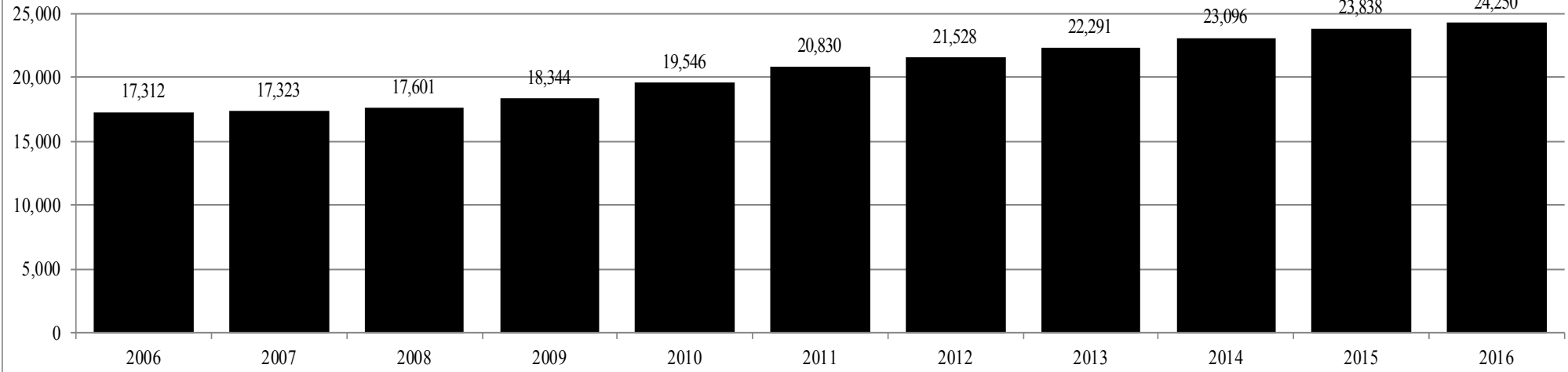

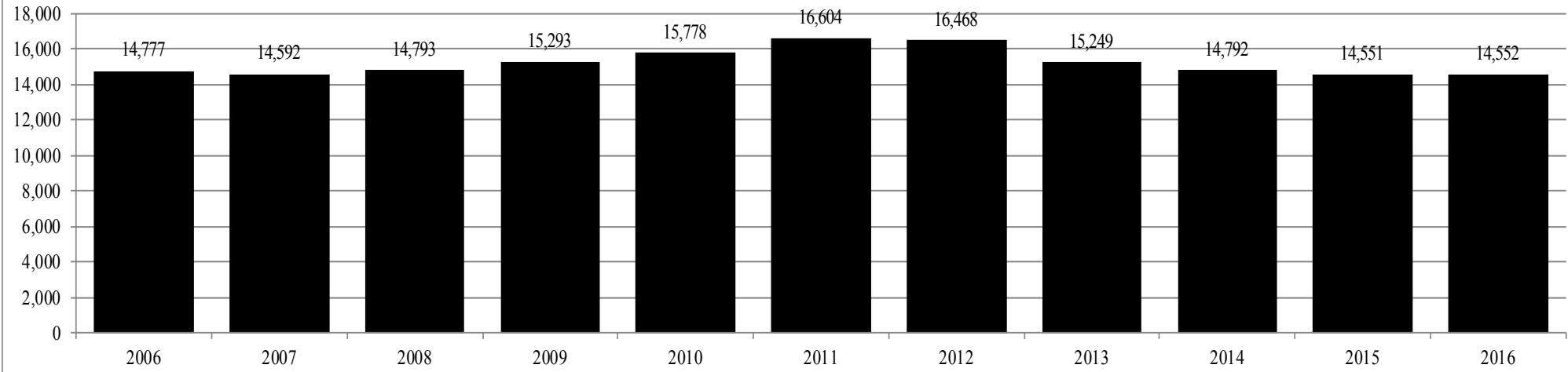
