

Subject: Class of 2016 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Exam Participation and Performance

#### **Advanced Placement Exam**

Students in the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Class of 2016 continued to outperform students in the state of Maryland on Advanced Placement (AP) examinations based on AP results released by the Maryland State Department of Education and the College Board. The number and percentage of AP exam participation and performance for the State of Maryland and the nation is different from the AP/IB exam results published in prior reports because Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education changed the projected number of high school graduates in the 9<sup>th</sup> Edition of *Knocking at the College Door*. In 2016, 65.5 percent of MCPS graduates took one or more AP exams, a rate that was 16.2 and 29.3 percentage points higher than the rate for public school graduates in Maryland (49.3 percent) and the nation (36.2 percent), respectively (Figure 1). From 2015 to 2016, the AP exam participation rate remained steady for MCPS, Maryland, and national graduates.




Figure 2. Advanced Placement exam performance of 2015 and 2016 public school graduates in MCPS, Maryland, and the nation

More than one half of the 2016 MCPS graduates earned at least one AP exam score of 3 or higher (51.3 percent), which was 20.9 and 29.4 percentage points greater than the rates for the public

school graduates in the state of Maryland (30.4 percent) and the nation (21.9 percent), respectively (Figure 2). The rate of earning a 3 or higher on at least one AP exam remained steady for MCPS graduates and the public school graduates in Maryland and the nation from 2015 to 2016.

As evidenced in tables included in the attachment (Tables A1–B3), MCPS high schools continued to support AP exam participation and performance for minority graduates. Between 2015 and 2016, 9 of the 25 high schools demonstrated an increase in the AP exam participation rate for Black or African American graduates and 10 of the 25 high schools had an increase in participation rate for Hispanic/Latino graduates (Tables A6a and A6b). Eight and 9 of the 25 high schools experienced an increase in the percentage of Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino graduates who earned an AP exam score of 3 or higher, respectively (Tables A8a and A8b). Five and six of the 25 high schools had increases for both AP exam participation and performance rates for Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino graduates, respectively (Tables A6a, A6b, A8a, and A8b).

Of note, for the Class of 2016, Clarksburg and Albert Einstein high schools demonstrated increases in both AP exam participation and performance for both Hispanic/Latino and Black or African American graduates (Tables A6a, A6b, A8a, and A8b). Five out of the 25 high schools—Montgomery Blair, Clarksburg, Albert Einstein, Poolesville, and Quince Orchard high schools—demonstrated an increase in AP exam participation for both Hispanic/Latino and Black or African American graduates. Three of the 25 high schools—Clarksburg, Albert Einstein, and Wheaton high schools—demonstrated an increase in AP exam performance for both Hispanic/Latino and Black or African American graduates.

### International Baccalaureate Exam

In addition to AP programs, MCPS also provides the International Baccalaureate (IB) program for students at selected high schools as an option for experiencing college-level coursework and earning college credits in high school. The IB program continues to grow, and MCPS high school students demonstrate a steady increase in IB course and exam participation. There are eight high schools in MCPS with IB programs. While Richard Montgomery High School

offered a countywide magnet IB program, the remaining seven high schools had school-based programs. In 2016, the percentage of MCPS graduates who took one or more IB exams (8.6 percent) increased 1.1 percentage points compared with 2014 MCPS graduates (7.5 percent) and the proportion of graduates who earned at least one IB exam score of 4 or higher remained close to unchanged (0.5 percentage points) (Table 1).

In the last three years, IB exam participation and performance varied across racial/ethnic groups. Slightly more than 1.0 percentage point of Black or African American graduates participated in IB exams than their peers in the Class of 2014, while the IB performance rate remained steady (0.2 percentage points decrease). Between 2014 and 2016, graduates of Two of More Races decreased participation and performance in IB exams by 1.7 and 1.9 percentage points, respectively. Conversely, Asian, Hispanic/Latino, and White graduates had increases in the rates of taking and earning an IB exam score of 4 or higher from 2014 to 2016.

Among the eight high schools offering IB programs, the proportion of 2016 graduates who took at least one IB exam ranged from 11.8 to 45.6 percent (Table B2). The wide range of IB participation rates reflected the varying degree of IB offerings in schools. On average, more than a quarter of these graduates earned at least one IB score of 4 or higher. From 2014 to 2016, five of the eight high schools with IB programs—John F. Kennedy, Rockville, Seneca Valley, Springbrook, and Watkins Mill high schools—demonstrated an increase in both IB exam participation and performance.

### AP/IB Exams as a Measure of College Readiness

One way to gauge students' college readiness is measured by an AP exam score of 3 or higher or an IB exam score of 4 or higher. The AP/IB exams are indicators to measure students' readiness for college-level coursework and the exam scores are used by colleges for possible course credits and advanced placement. From 2014 to 2016, the AP/IB participation and performance rates of MCPS graduates remained steady (Table 2). Among racial/ethnic groups, Black or African American and White graduates demonstrated an increase in the participation rate by 2.1 and 1.4 percentage points with a corresponding increase in the performance rate

by 2.3 and 2.6 percentage points, respectively. Hispanic/Latino graduates and graduates identified as Two or More Races had decreases both in participation (2.7 and 5.2 percentage points) and performance rates (2.3 and 4.4 percentage points). Asian graduates' participation rate remained steady, while the performance rate increased slightly by 1.2 percentage points.

Among service groups, the AP/IB participation and performance rates for the graduates who received Free and Reduced-price Meals System services remained stable from 2014 to 2016 (Table 2). The participation rates for graduates who received special education services and those with Limited English Proficiency decreased 2.5 and 12.1 percentage points and their performance rates declined 1.4 and 8.0 percentage points, respectively.

Table B3 displays similar data to that of Table B2, but provides detailed information by student group for each high school only for the Class of 2016.
