

Utah 2018 Graduation Rates

Graduation Rate Highlights

- Utah's state graduation rate for the 2018 cohort is 87%.
- A total of 41,322 students graduated from Utah's high schools.
- Students who identify as Asian had the highest graduation rate - 92% - for the 2018 cohort.
- Utah's graduation rate has increased from 81% in 2013 to 87% in 2018.

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Current Graduation Rates

The graduation rate for the 2018 cohort was 87%. This is a one percentage point increase from the 2017 cohort's graduation rate of 86%. Students who identify as Asian maintained the highest graduation rate in 2018 at 92%. All student groups in the 2018 cohort saw an increase in their graduation rate except for the Pacific Islander (a one percentage point decrease) and economically disadvantaged (no change) student groups. Appendix A provides an overview on how graduation rates are calculated.

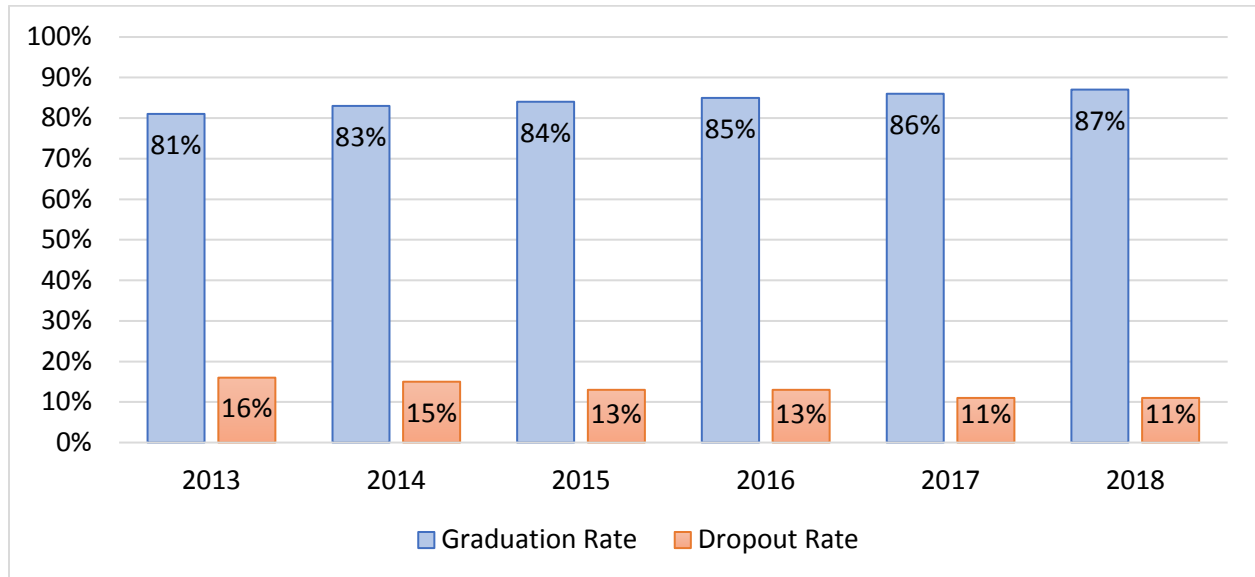

Historical Graduation Rates

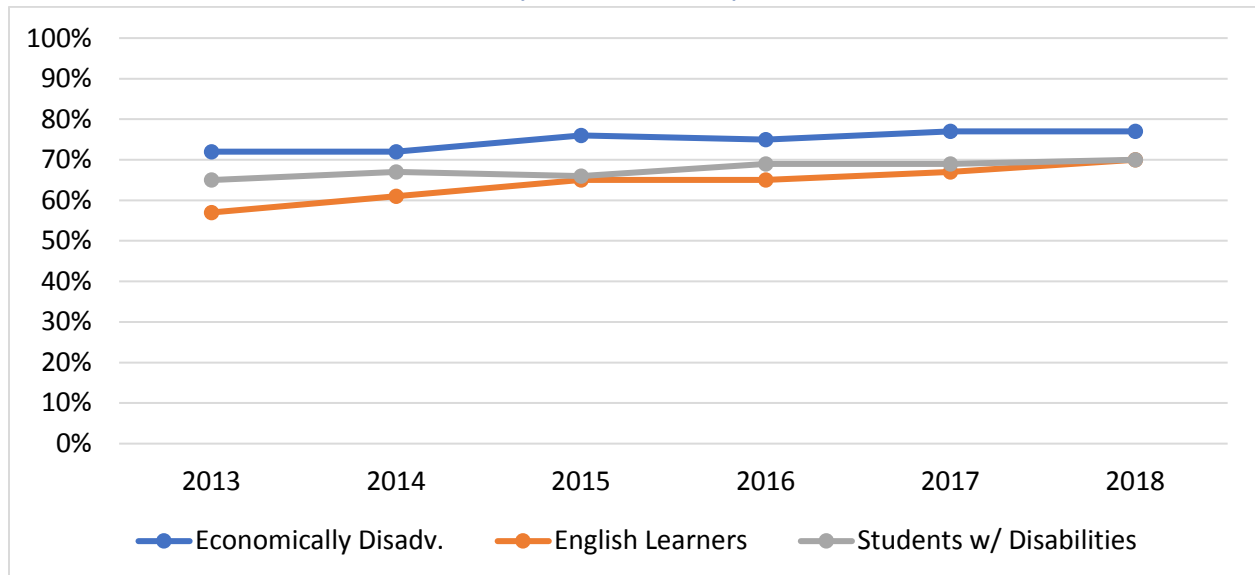
Utah’s graduation rate has increased a total of six percentage points (from 81% to 87%) over the last six years. Over the same period the dropout rate has decreased by five percentage points (from 16% to 11%). The remaining two to three percent of students each year are ‘other completers’ or ‘continuing students’.

Exhibit 2: Utah’s Graduation and Dropout Rates, Cohort Year 2013 to 2018



Students who are economically disadvantaged maintained a graduation rate of 77% from the 2017 to the 2018 cohort. Students with a disability and students who are English learners increased their graduation rates to 70% from 69% and 67%, respectively.

Exhibit 3: Utah’s Graduation Rates by Student Group, Cohort Year 2013 to 2018



All racial/ethnic student groups have made consistent improvements in their graduation rates from cohort year 2013 to 2018. Most notably the graduation rate has increased by 13 percentage points (from 79% to 92%) among students who identify as Asian. This is followed by a 12 percentage point increase (from 65% to 77%) among students who identify as American Indian, and a 10 percentage point increase (from 68% to 78%) among students who identify as Hispanic/Latino. Exhibit 5 shows graduation rates by student group from cohort year 2013 to 2018.

Exhibit 4: Utah’s Graduation Rates by Race/Ethnicity, Cohort Years 2013 to 2018

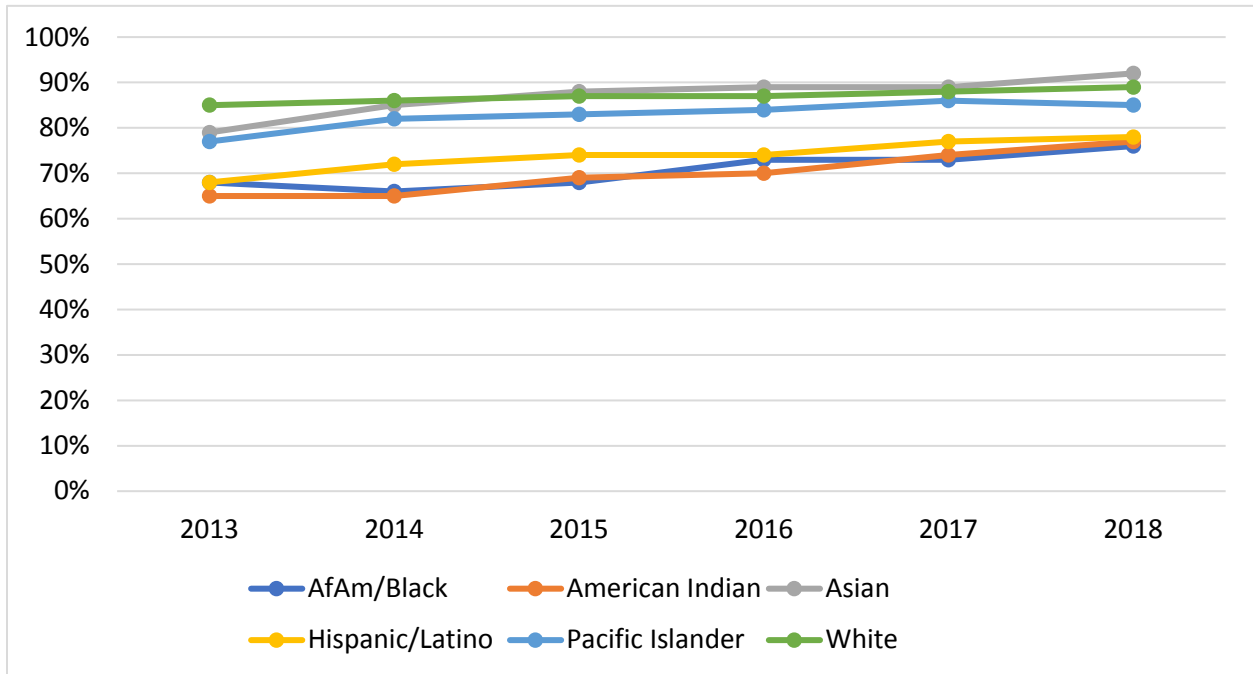

Graduation Rates by LEA and School

Exhibits 6 and 7 show the 2018 cohort count and graduation rate, as well as the graduation rates for cohort years 2016 and 2017 for each Local Education Agency (LEA) and school. Exhibit 6 shows districts and district schools, and Exhibit 7 shows charter agencies and charter schools.

In compliance with FERPA regulations and student data privacy best practices, data for groups with fewer than ten students is reported as “n<10.” For groups with fewer than ten students, counts are not shown and percentages are obscured by providing the range within which the percentage falls (e.g., 43% would display as 40-49%). Percentages that are close to 100% or 0% are also not reported. This is indicated by a ≤ or > (e.g., ≥95%). Blanks in the 2016 or 2017 Graduation Rate column indicate that the school did not have a graduation rate that cohort year.

Appendix A: Background on Graduation Rates

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires the state to calculate a four-year cohort rate. Utah implemented a federally defined cohort graduation rate in 2008. The graduation rate for the 2018 cohort includes all students who started ninth grade in the 2014-15 school year, plus students who transferred into the Utah public education system after ninth grade.

Students in the cohort have four possible final outcomes:

- Graduate
- Continuing student
- Other completer
- Dropout

The “graduate” category includes students who have earned a basic high school diploma, Alternate Diploma (for students with a significant cognitive disability as defined in Board Rule R277-705-2), or an adult education high school diploma by September 30 following the end of their cohort school year. “Continuing students” are students who have been allowed to continue attending school beyond their senior year, or those who transferred to higher education or the Utah System of Technological Colleges (formerly UCAT) without first receiving a high school diploma. Students considered “other completers” include those who completed the General Education Development test (GED) or a certificate of completion; or are a student with a disability who participated in the Utah Alternate Assessment (UAA). The “dropout” category includes students who have not completed graduation requirements, such as those who have withdrawn, dropped out, or have been expelled.
