How many instructional hours are required for kindergarten?

At least 41 states addressed age exemptions or waivers in reference to kindergarten entrance in state statute and/or regulations. At least 10 states plus the District of Columbia did not articulate specific exemption or waiver opportunities in statute or regulations.
