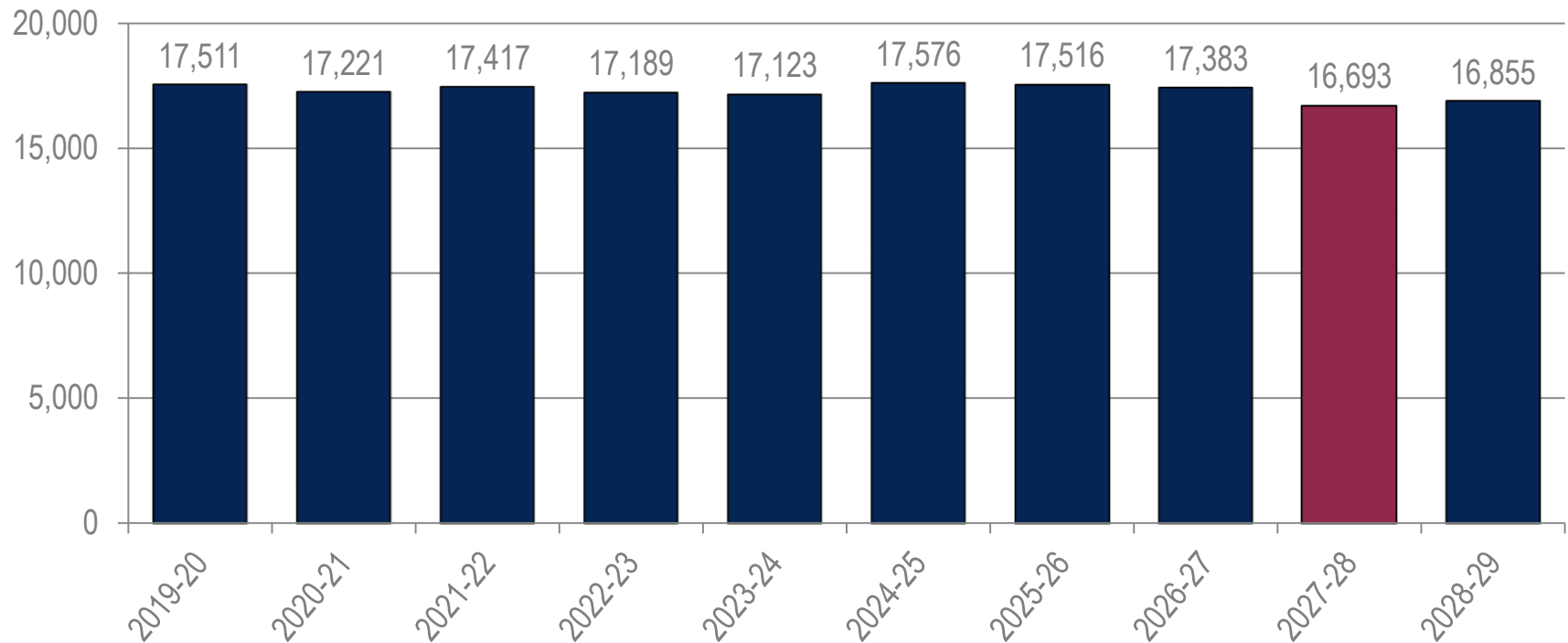

According to WICHE, the number of graduates produced by public and private high schools in West Virginia will reach a **ten-year low of 16,693** in 2027.

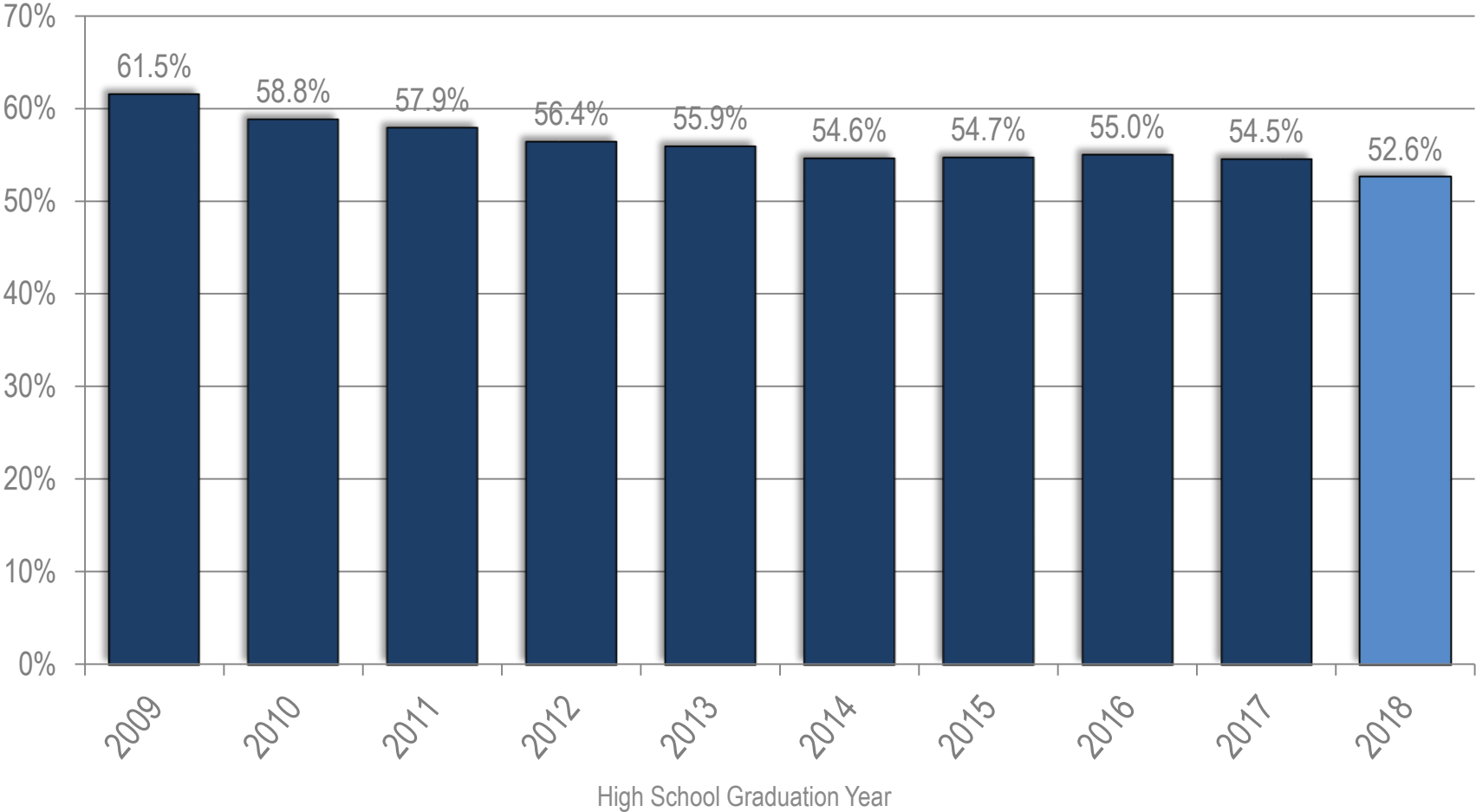

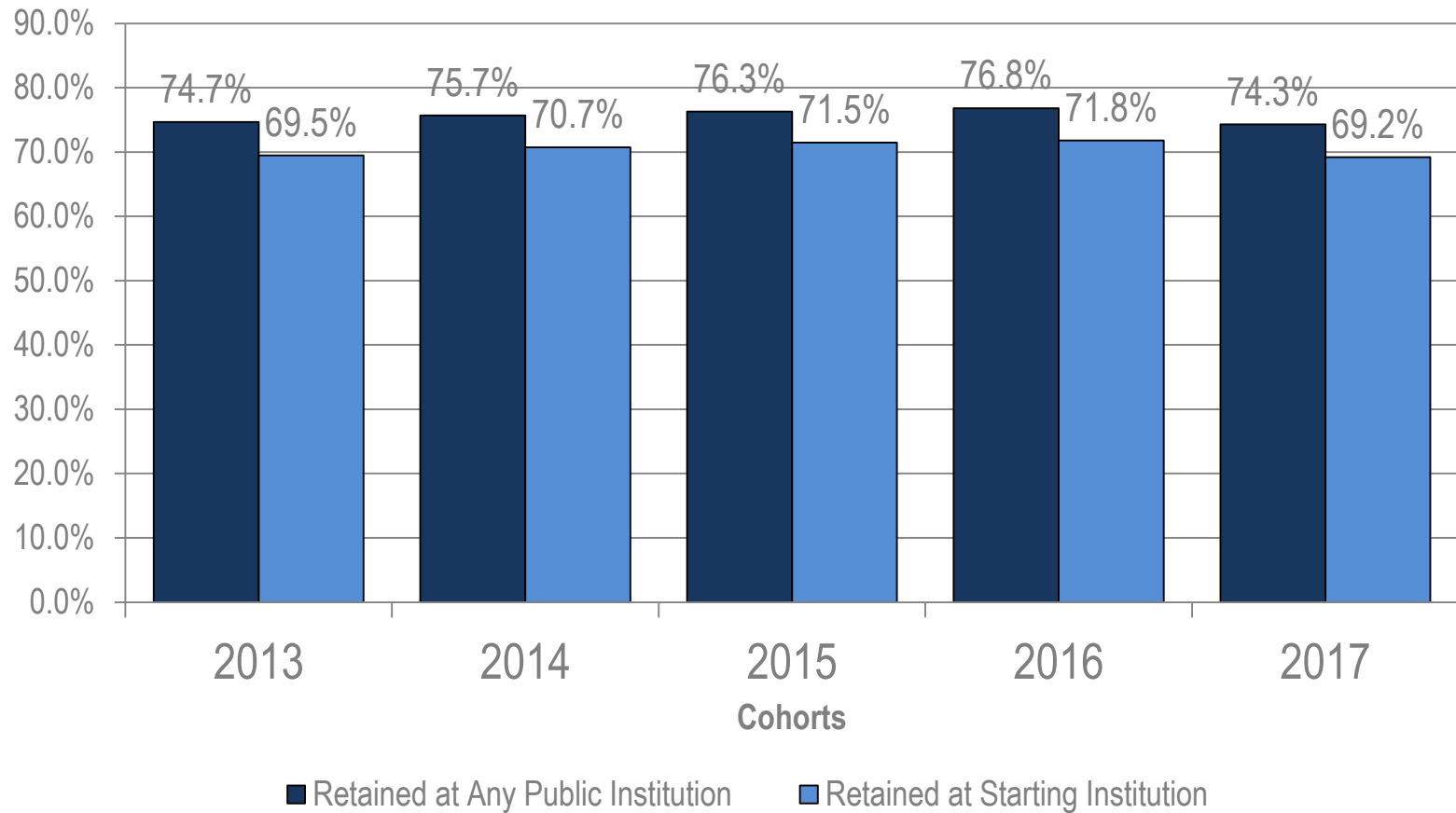
# College-Going Rate

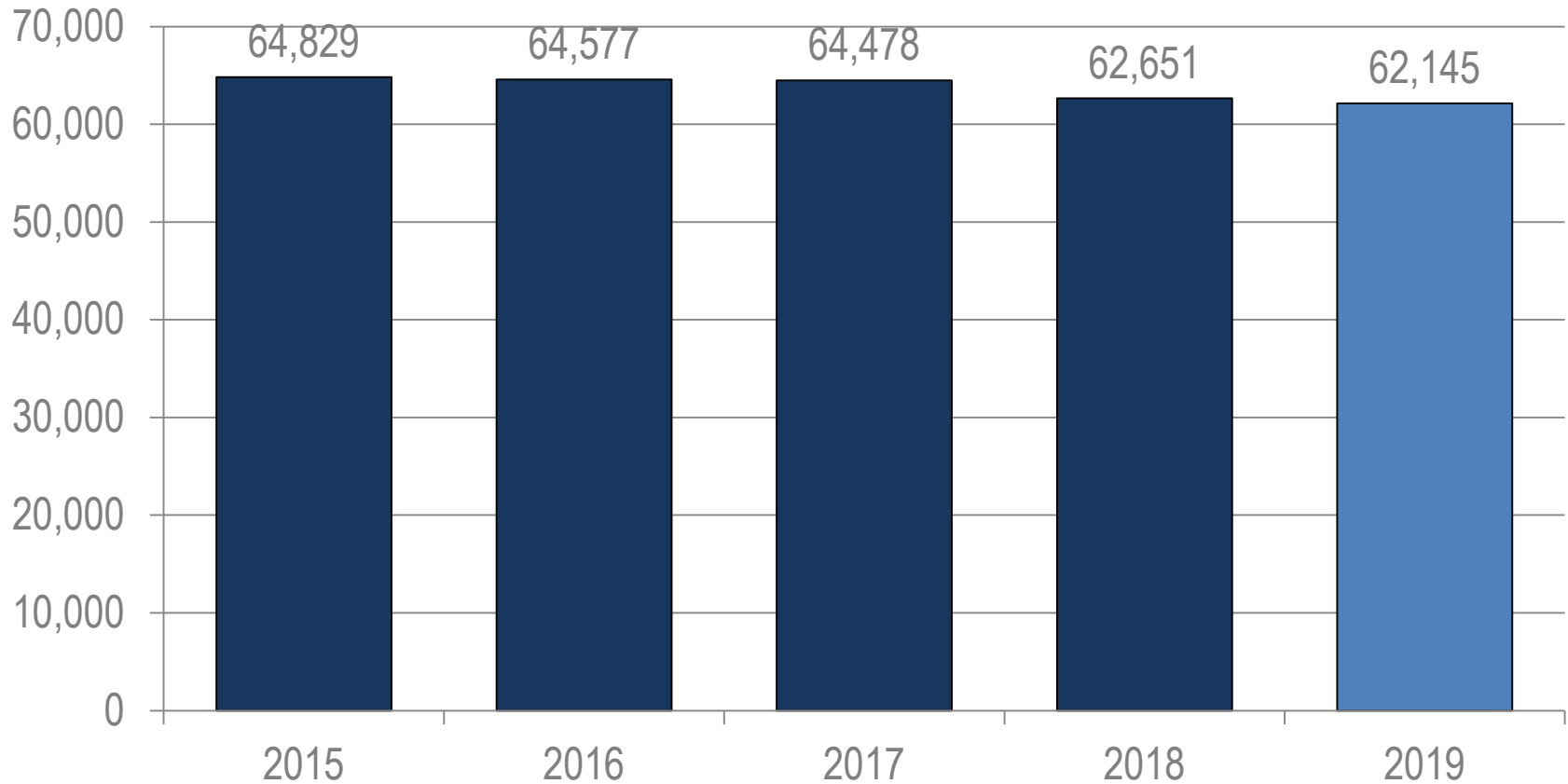

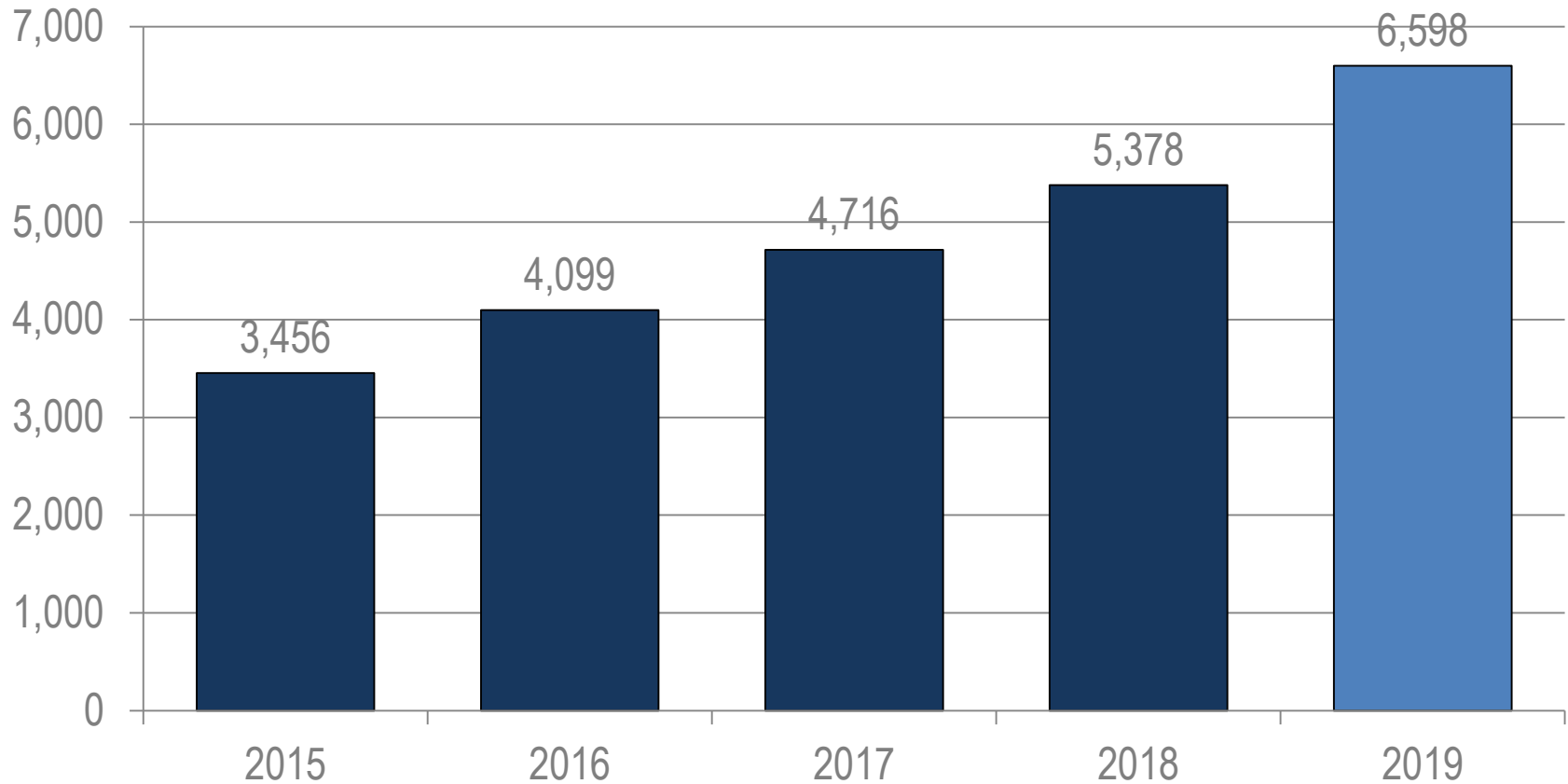




# High School Dual Enrollment Headcount

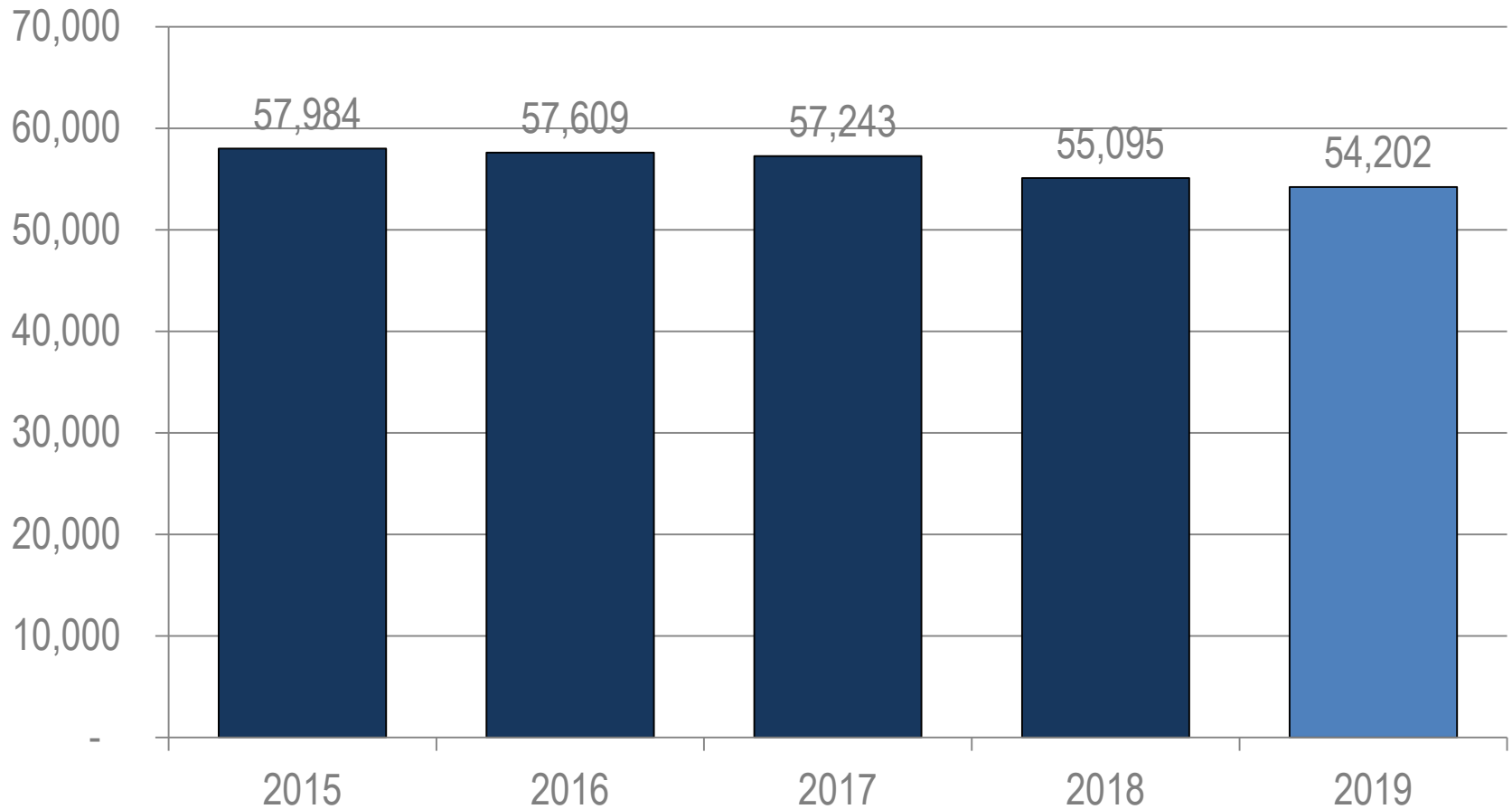

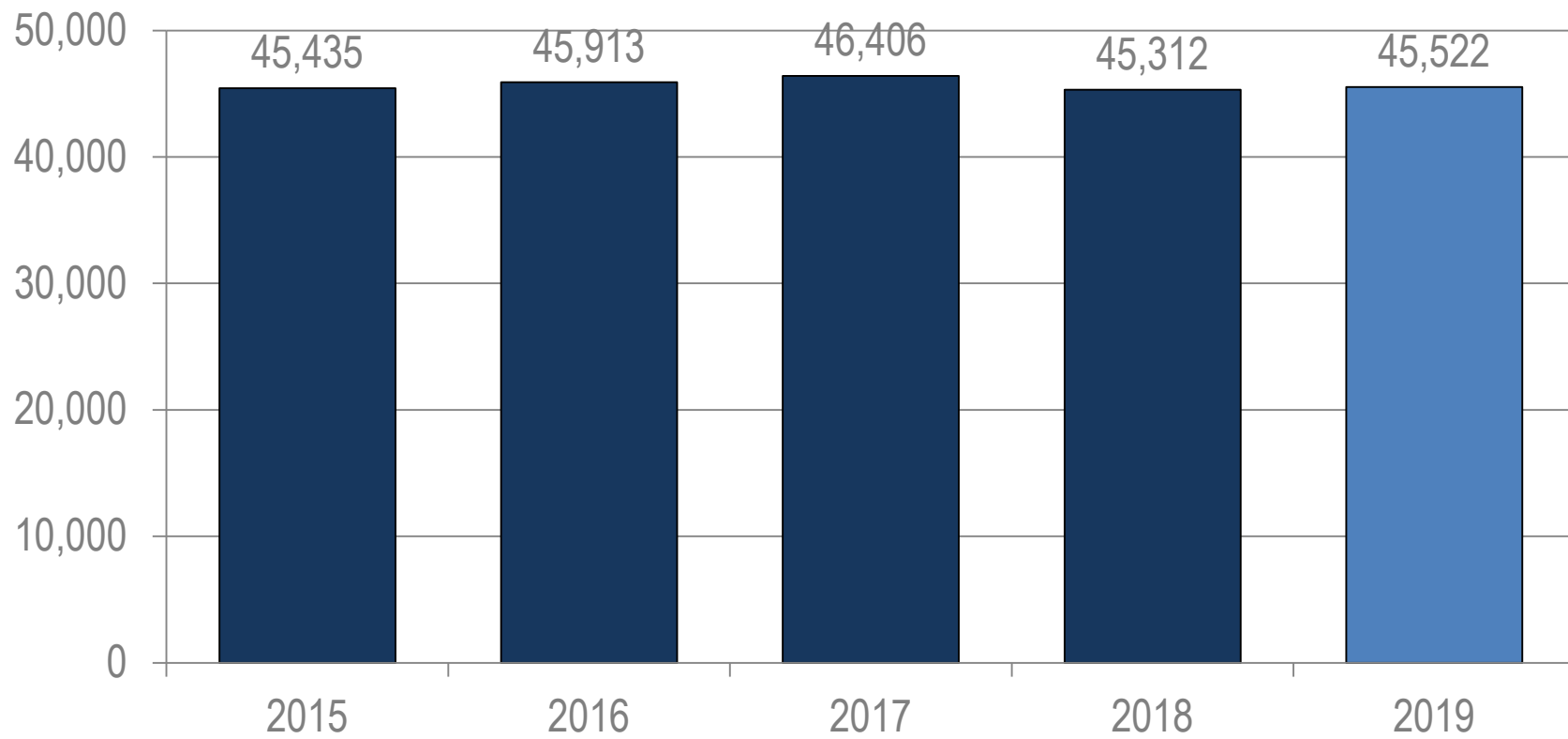

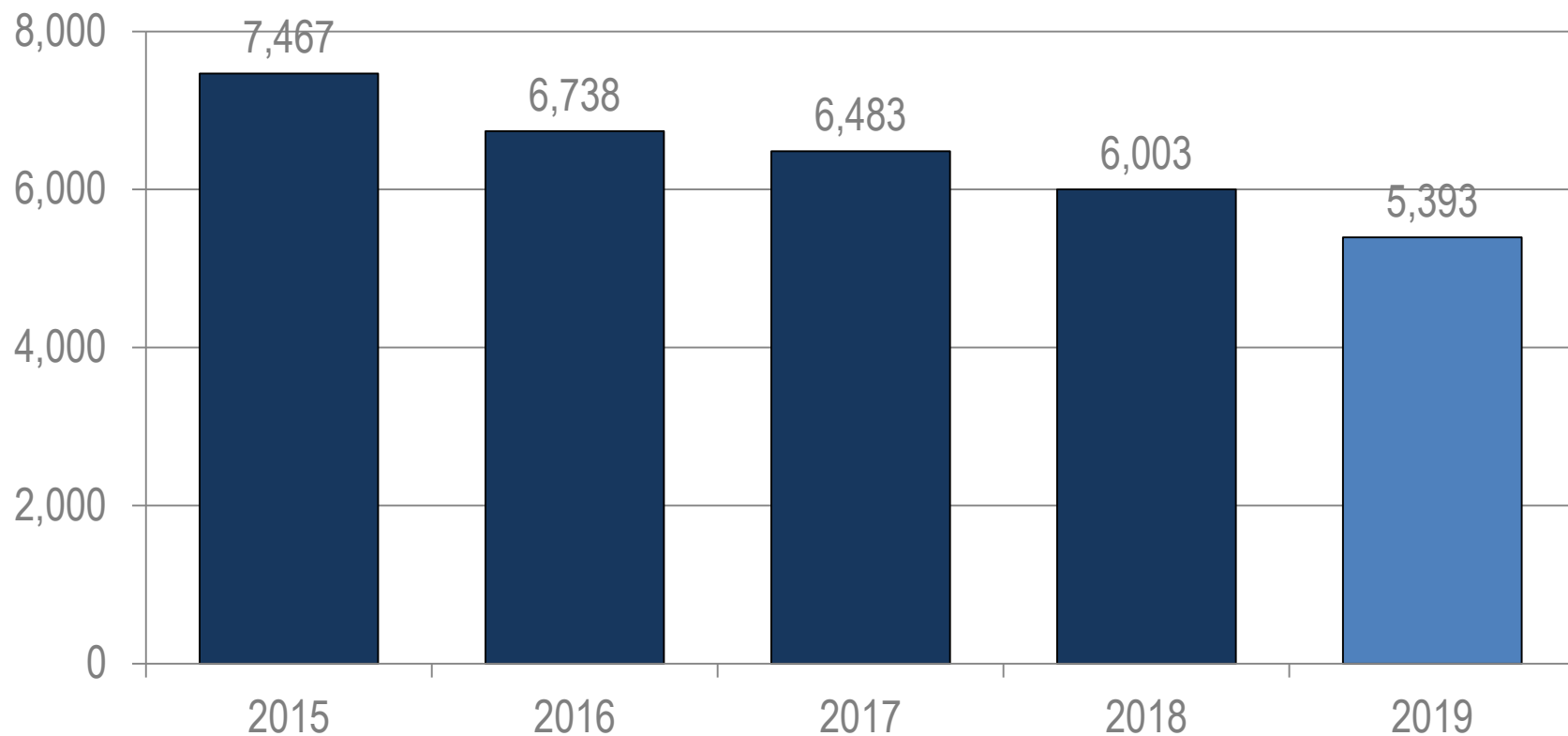

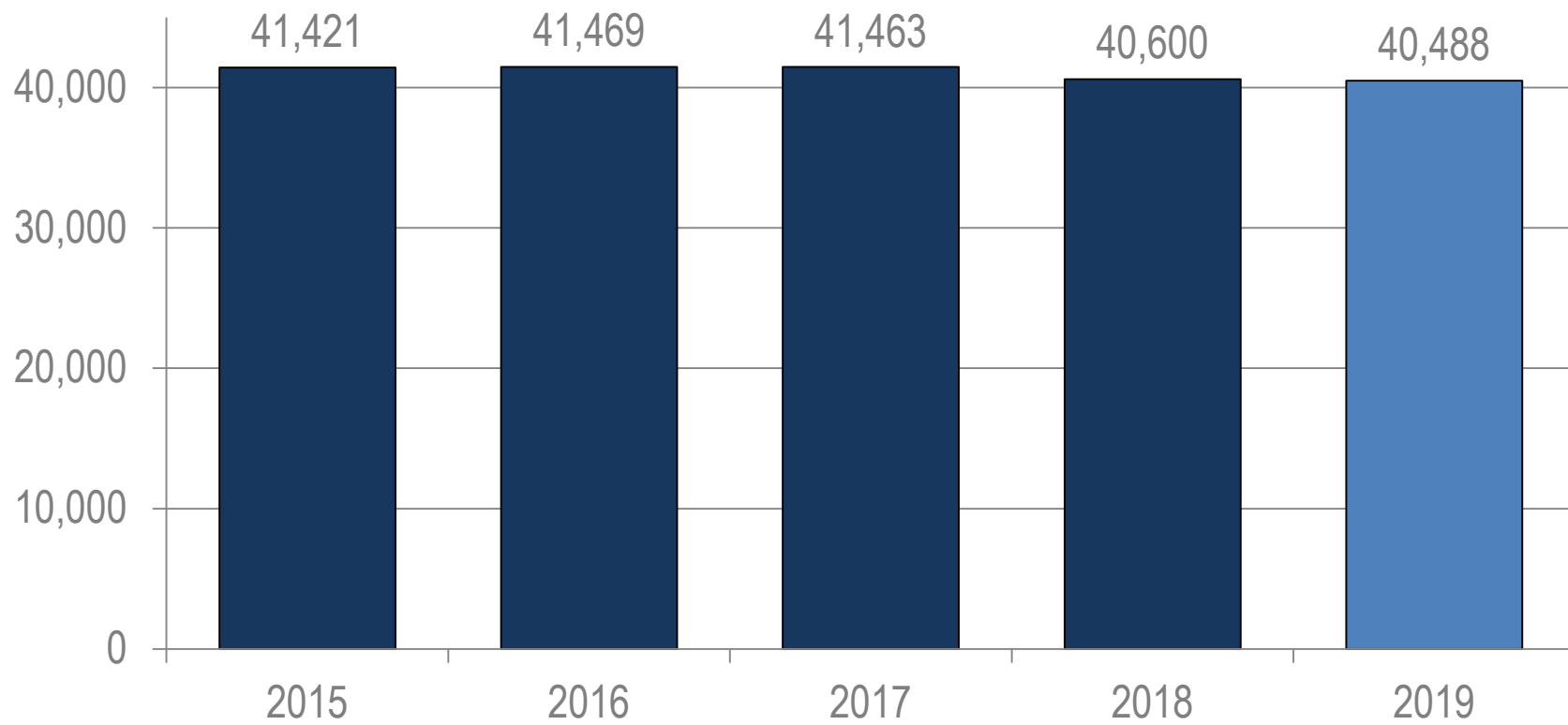

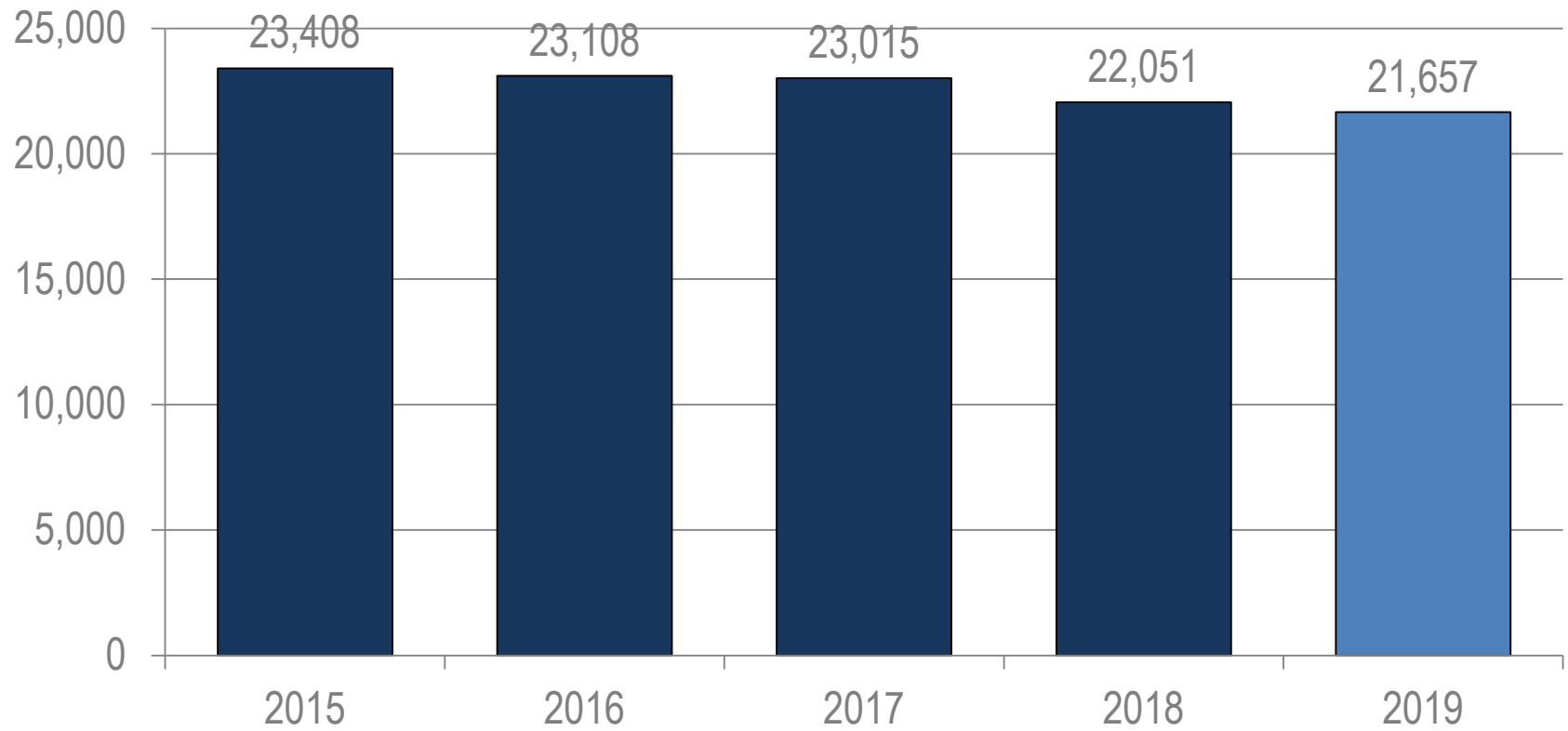

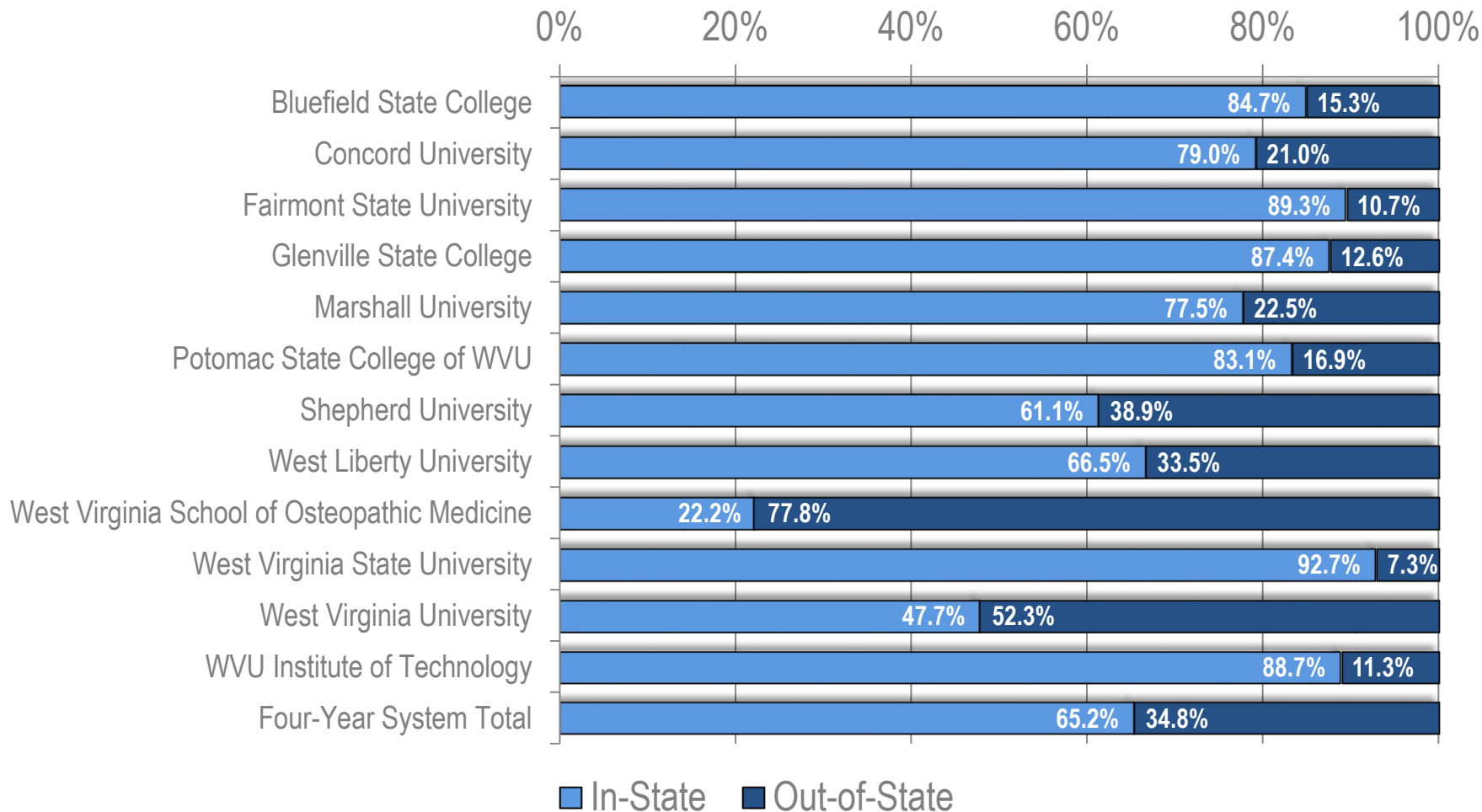

# Headcount Enrollment by Residency



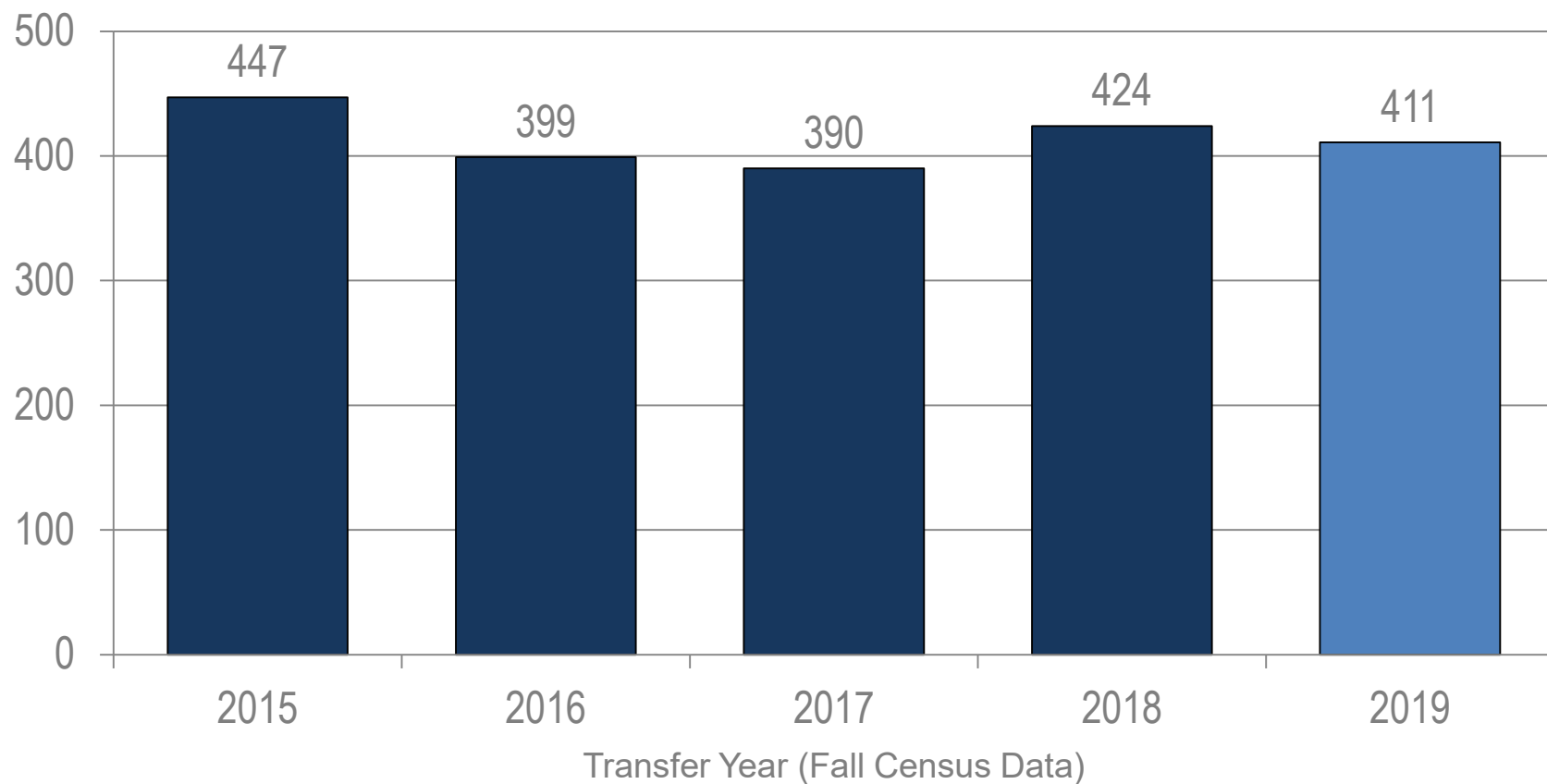
