PEABODY RESULTS, BY VERTICAL TEAM FALL 2013

RESEARCH BRIEF

How did prekindergarten (pre-K) students perform on the Peabody Picture Vocabulary Test (PPVT) and the Test de Vocabulario en Imágenes (TVIP) in Fall 2013? District wide, Austin Independent School District (AISD) pre-K students' average normal curve equivalent (NCE) score of 40.4 was in the *low average* range on the Peabody (Tables 1 and 2). On average, English language learners (ELLs) scored lower on the Peabody than did non-ELLs.

Each year in the fall and spring semesters, the PPVT and the TVIP (i.e., Spanish version of the PPVT) are provided to a sample of pre-K students across all AISD elementary campuses with a pre-K program. In 2013-2014 the sample was stratified to be representative of each vertical team.

A total of 2,062 pre-K students were tested in Fall 2013. Of those tested, 158 were not tested in their home language; in most cases, those students had a home language other than Spanish or English. Because PPVT/TVIP is age normed on native English and Spanish speakers, students not tested in their home language were eliminated from the analysis.

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How did Peabody performance compare across vertical teams? On average, the Austin and Bowie elementary school vertical teams had the highest Peabody pretest NCEs across the district and Johnson and Reagan elementary school vertical teams had the lowest Peabody pretest NCEs across the district.

Although non-ELLs, on average, scored higher on the Peabody than did ELLs, pre-K ELLs in the Eastside Memorial vertical team scored significantly¹ higher on the Peabody than did non-ELLs at those schools. Conversely, ELLs in the Anderson, Crockett, and McCallum vertical teams scored significantly lower on the Peabody than did non-ELLs at those schools.

How did Peabody performance compare across early childhood centers? Pre-K students at Read, Dobie, and Webb scored lower, on average, on the Peabody than did pre-K students district wide. On average, ELLs scored lower than non-ELLs, except for students at Read and Uphaus.
