

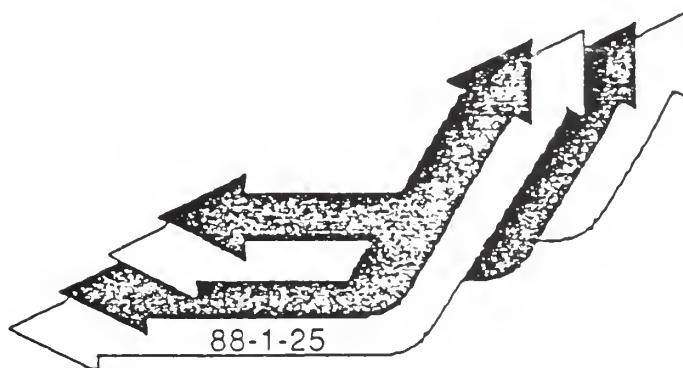

Sources of Data

All estimates in this tabulation were based on the High School and Beyond senior cohort. Data elements used in this analysis were drawn from the base year, first, second, and third follow-up surveys. In addition, the Senior Enrollment file was used to construct several variables describing the amount of enrollment and attainment in postsecondary education.

Row variables were selected from the standard set of LSB classification variables.¹ A detailed description of the column variables appears below. Some variables were repeated with the number of categories reduced. These instances have been noted with the term (RECODED) after the variable name. All estimates were calculated using FU3WT to represent all 1980 high school sophomores in the United States.

High School and Beyond samples, while representative and statistically accurate, are not simple random samples. Students were initially selected within high schools grouped within strata. Sampling rates for schools within different strata varied, resulting in better data for policy purposes, but at a cost to statistical efficiency. Hence, simple random techniques for the estimation of standard errors frequently underestimate the true standard errors. To overcome this problem, standard errors for all estimates in this tabulation were calculated using Taylor residual techniques. All estimates, standard errors, unweighted n's and weighted n's are available from the Longitudinal Studies Branch in comma separated form for use with all major spreadsheet software and micro computers.

Column Definitions

In most instances the variables used in this survey were drawn directly from questionnaire responses. These are described in detail in the High School and Beyond 1980 Senior Cohort Third Follow-up (1986) User's Manual. In a few instances, responses were used to create new variables. The construction of new variables and labels given to column variables used in these tables are described below.

These tables show student enrollment in postsecondary education in three types of institutions: four-year schools, two-year schools, and vocational schools. All of the two-year schools were junior colleges, and these terms are used interchangeably. In Tables 1 and 2, both two-year and vocational schools are grouped together and referred to as "other schools."

Three types of attainment in postsecondary education are shown in these tables: four-year degrees, A.A. degrees, and vocational certificates. Four-year degrees include the Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor of Science degrees. The Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree is a two-year certificate. Most were awarded by junior colleges, although some four-year schools also award such degrees. Certificates include those awarded after a two-year program as well as those awarded after a shorter term. Students were credited with as many degrees as they earned, not just the highest degree.

Regardless of student report, degrees were credited only to those students who reported attendance in postsecondary education. Some students who reported earning certificates after high school had not attended any postsecondary education. These students were classified with students who had no educational attainment after high school, since these certificates did not come from any postsecondary training. Similarly, students who reported receiving licenses to practice a trade were classified on the basis of their educational attainment, not on the basis of having received a license from the state government.

Several abbreviations are common to many tables in this tabulation. Postsecondary education is often designated by "PSE," part-time enrollment by "P/T," full-time enrollment by "F/T," certificate by "Cert" or "Certif," vocational by "Voc," junior college by "Jr Coll," Received by "Recvd," public by "Pub" and private by "Prv," high school by "HS," education by "Ed" or "Educ," professional by "Profl" handicapped by "Hcp," and school by "Sch."

The timing of events is often expressed as "by" a certain year (e.g., "by 1980"). The exact time period indicated is different for enrollment and attainment. When Table 3 shows student attainment by a certain year, in each case the student had received the degree reported by February of that year. However, in Table 1 the year listed in each column is the start of the academic year. Thus the label for column two of Table 1, "Enter 4 Year School by 1980," refers to those who entered a four-year school during the 1980-81 school year. In all cases where the year "1986" or "by 1986" is mentioned, the time period summarized ends in February 1986, when the interviews for the third follow-up survey began.

Table 7 compares students with different enrollment status. "Mixed Status" includes those who attended some full-time and some part-time during their postsecondary careers.

Table 8 divides the timing of student enrollment in postsecondary education according into two categories. "Entered by Oct" and "Entered 10/80" to those who entered postsecondary education by October 1980. "Entered Later" refers to those entering after October 1980.

When the last three columns in Table 9a compare educational expectations at high school graduation to attainment in postsecondary education by 1986, this comparison is expressed as three categories: attainment lower than expectations, attainment equal to expectations, and attainment higher than expectations. These categories were constructed by comparing the level of expectations reported in the base year survey (1980) with the amount and type of postsecondary enrollment and attainment attributed to the student on the basis of reports during the first, second, and third follow-up surveys (1982, 1984, and 1986). Students were placed in the following categories for their expectations and attainment: no high school diploma, high school diploma only, less than two years of vocational school, two years or more of vocational school, less than two years of college, two or more years of college, a B.A. or B.S. degree, and an advanced degree. Since the 1980 high school seniors were still working on graduate degrees by the time of the interviews, students with four-year degrees who were still enrolled in school were classified as having achieved an advanced degree for purposes of this comparison. While some of these will not actually attain the degree they seek, they had made as much progress as was possible by February 1986.

Table 9b divides students according to their plans for postsecondary education in 1980. "Planned PSE" includes all those who planned to attend some postsecondary

education. "Planned Grad" includes those who planned to earn four-year degrees and those who planned to earn advanced degrees.

Percentaging of Tables

In most of these tables, percentages are based on the table's entire sample and the group shown is described by the column and row labels. Even in Tables 4, 5, and 6, the percentages with degrees in each field are shown as a percentage of the table's entire sample, not as a percentage of those who received degrees.

In Tables 7, 8, and 9b, percentages are based on the descriptor before the colon. Thus the second column in Table 7 shows the percentage of those who attended full-time only who had no degree and were out of school. Where the descriptor after the colon is "Total Percent," the columns show the percentage of those described before the colon out of the table's entire sample.
