SUBJECT: **Class of 2021 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Exam Participation and Performance**

Summary

- This memorandum provides information pertinent to the participation and performance of Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations for 2021 graduates in Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). In 2021, 66.6 percent of MCPS graduates took one or more AP exams, a rate that was 23.0 and 31.7 percentage points higher than the rate for public school graduates in Maryland (43.6 percent) and the nation (34.9 percent), respectively. Districtwide, 53.2 percent of the 2021 MCPS graduates earned at least one AP exam score of 3 or higher, while 66.6 percent of the public school graduates in the state of Maryland and 22.5 percent of the national graduates in public schools attained an AP score of 3 or higher.
- The three-year trend data for AP exam participation and performance for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino continued to rise across MCPS high schools. From 2019 to 2021, Bethesda Chevy-Chase, Blake, John F. Kennedy, Poolesville, Seneca Valley, and Springbrook high Schools demonstrated increases in both AP exam participation and performance for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino. Bethesda Chevy-Chase, Blake, John F. Kennedy, Poolesville, Seneca Valley, Springbrook, Watkins Mill, and Thomas S. Wootton high schools demonstrated an increase in AP exam participation for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino. Bethesda Chevy-Chase, Blake, Clarksburg, Albert Einstein, John F. Kennedy, Poolesville, Rockville, Seneca Valley, Springbrook, and Wheaton high schools demonstrated an increase in AP exam performance for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino.
- Districtwide, the IB exam participation declined by 1.4 percentage points in the last three years. The proportion of graduates who earned at least one IB exam score of 4 or higher remained flat from 6.8 percent in 2019 to 6.5 percent in 2021.
- In 2021, the proportion of graduates who took at least one IB exam ranged from 19.0 to 32.9 percent. The percentage of graduates in the Class of 2021 who earned at least one IB score of 4 or higher varied from 16.6 to 29.2 percent across all schools offering the IB programs. From 2019 to 2021, only Rockville high school demonstrated an increase in both IB exam participation and performance for all students.
- AP and IB exams are indicators for students' readiness for college-level coursework and exam scores are used by colleges for possible course credit and placement of students in non-introductory courses. One way to gauge students' college readiness is measured by an AP exam score of 3 or higher or an IB exam score of 4 or higher. Although the performance rate on AP/IB examinations increased 0.9 percentage point from 2019 to 2021, the AP/IB participation rate for MCPS graduates decreased from 68.9 percent in 2019 to 67.4 percent in 2021.
