Trends for 6th Grade

Which schools had greatest declines in 6th grade enrollment, and how many more students should they have received?

Table 1

Four schools experienced a 6th grade enrollment decline of more than 20 students.

Two of those schools (Dobie and Burnet) were zoned to receive more than 130 students who left AISD during or after 5th grade.
