Understanding the Data

This summary presents postsecondary enrollment rates for AISD's Classes of 2011 to 2014. Direct-to-College is defined as students who enroll the Fall immediately following their high school graduation date. Postsecondary enrollment results for the Class of 2014 are considered preliminary. The graduate file was submitted to NSC in December 2014 before it was finalized in the state reporting process. The results for the Class of 2014 will be updated in Summer 2015 using the final version of the 2014 graduate data file.
