Industry presenters will give a 25-minute presentation, followed by 5 minutes reserved for questions. Submission of a written paper is not required. The submitted abstract will be listed in the conference record, but the presentation materials will not be published in the conference record or on IEEE Xplore. Presentations should be focused on the technical aspects; purely promotional submissions will be rejected. One presenter of each topic must have full registration and present in person at the Conference.
