La Balade pour la Paix: An Open-air *Museum* is part of the official program for the 375th anniversay of Montréal. The exhibition was designed and organized by the Montral Museum of Fine Arts with the support of McGill University. La Balade pour *la Paix* occupies a kilometre of Sherbrooke Street between the MMFA and Concordia University, on one end, and the McCord Museum and McGill University, on the other. Some thirty monumental sculptures by contemporary artists from several countries and the five main regions of Canada are on display.
