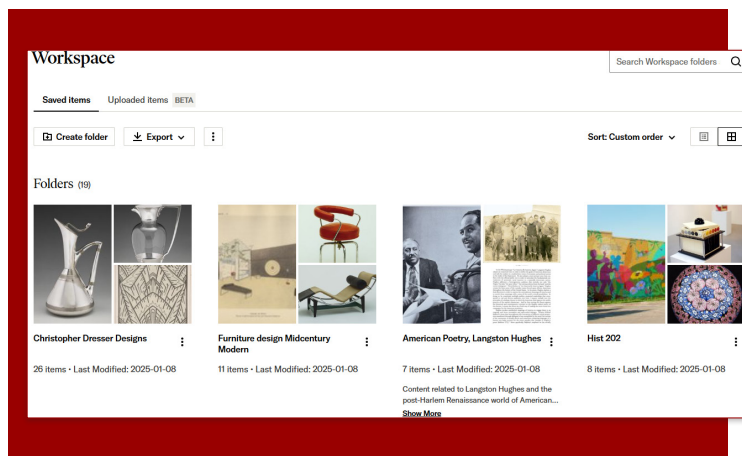
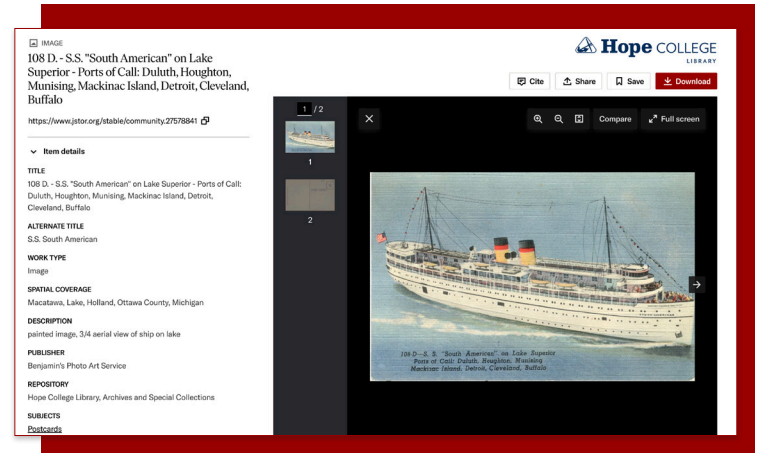
JSTOR is a digital library of academic journals, books, and research reports alongside primary sources in multiple formats.

Using JSTOR

With one search on JSTOR you can find academic content in the humanities, social sciences, and sciences.

Get easy access to journal articles, book chapters, and research reports. Plus, discover new avenues of investigation and gain deeper understanding of your topics with original materials including artworks, photographs, publications, oral histories, and multimedia recordings.

You can save or download what you find and get pre-formatted MLA, APA, or Chicago citations.



JSTOR Workspace

Your Workspace is where you can save, organize, annotate and even share what you find on JSTOR.

Utilize the JSTOR Workspace by creating a personal account on JSTOR. To start using Workspace, register for a free account at the top of any page on JSTOR when you are on campus or accessing JSTOR through your library website.

Accessing JSTOR

JSTOR is available from anywhere, on any device.

When you get to JSTOR, check the banner at the top of the page to find out if you already have access to JSTOR through your institution.

If the banner says “Access provided by ...” then you can proceed to finding sources.

If the banner says “Have library access? ...” you will need to log in through your institution. Click on the “Log in” link in the banner or at the top of the page. You can log in using the institution finder, Google or Microsoft SSO, or with your own credentials.

We recommend contacting your library if you are having any difficulty accessing JSTOR.

Create a personal JSTOR account using the “Register” option to have seamless access to JSTOR. Your personal account will be automatically linked to your institution.

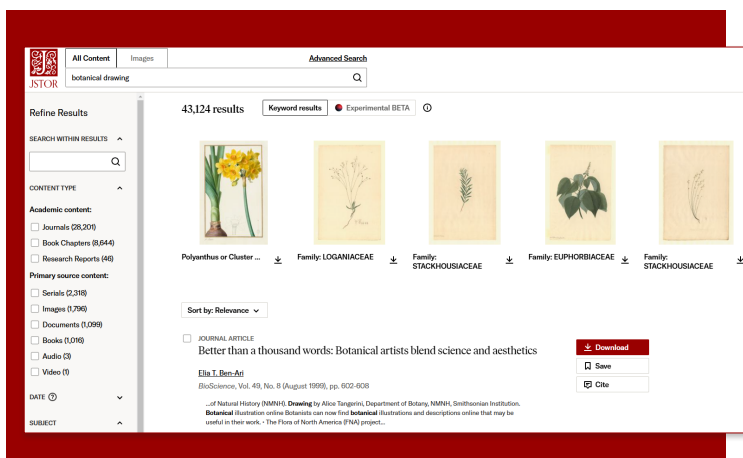

JSTOR supports full-text keyword searching across all of the content on the platform.

The fields and checkboxes in the Refine Results sidebar allow you to filter your search results.

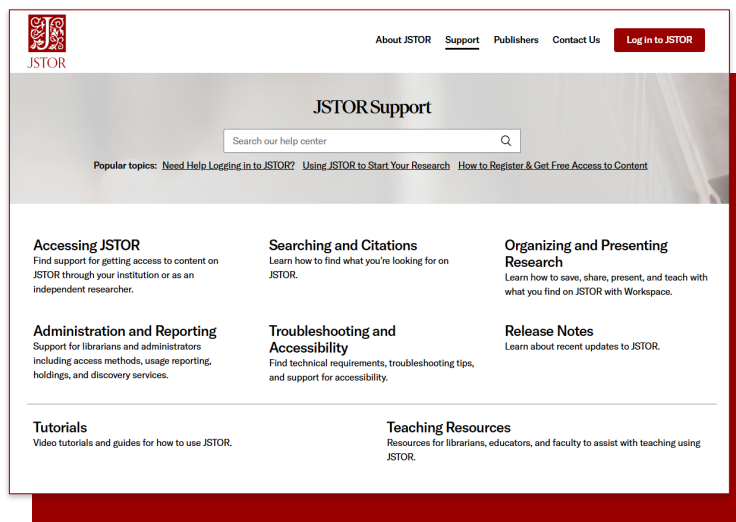
You can add or change your filters as you explore the results. This versatility allows you to browse extensively from one search query.
