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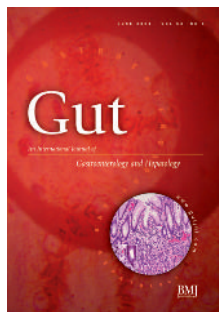
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Phenotype of hereditary diffuse gastric cancer (from the paper by Charlton *et al*, pp 814–820).



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
