Abstracts for Technical Papers should be one page in length and highlight the main features of the proposed and previously unpublished paper dealing with one or more of the important aspects of System Readiness suggested above. Session proposals should include proposed papers, presentations, and speakers. Abstracts for technical papers must be submitted electronically at the URL indicated below. A copyright release will be required at the time of submission for each technical paper selected for inclusion in the AUTOTESTCON 2010 Technical Program. All AUTOTESTCON 2010 participants, including authors, presenters, session chairs, and exhibitors must register for the conference. A Student Paper Awards program for both Graduate and Undergraduate student papers includes cash awards of \$500 for best papers in both categories, plus travel subsidies ranging from \$300 to \$1000 depending on student location.
