July MD Highlights

It appears that the larger decreases in overall membership due to COVID-19 peaked in May. For the second month in a row we have seen the rate of decline recede. The largest decline point in May was –5.9%, subsiding slightly in June to -5.8%. As of July, overall membership is behind –5.5%.

This change represents about 500 members more recovered for the month. Renewal activity was well above what it normally is in July due to campaigns launching later than normal. Specifically, higher grade renewal activity was the main driver, as student renewal activity remained steady.

Recruitment activity also continues to show signs of a rebound but is still behind. The overall decline in recruitment changed from -10.5% in June to -10.1% this month. As with renewal activity, higher grade recruitment activity was on par for this time of year, while student recruitment was slightly below average.

Here are some key points to note as we enter the new membership year:


- The 2020 membership year officially ends on 15 August. Membership numbers included here reflect July month-end. There will be one more report on the 2020 membership year for activity through August.
- As of 16 August 2020 anyone joining IEEE becomes a member for the 2021 membership year. The
 membership is effective immediately and continues through December 2021.
- For renewing members, they can renew for 2021 online beginning 8 September.
- Student members with a graduation date in 2021 will be elevated to higher grade member status. As a
 Recent Graduate they will receive an automatic 50% discount on their first year of higher grade
 membership when they renew.
- On 1 October, we will begin mailing the first renewal notices to members and society affiliates. A series
 of email communications will follow from October 2020 through February 2021.

2020 Membership Continues to Improve in the Midst of COVID-19

Society membership (including Affiliates) is down 4,989, or 1.6% in 2020 as of month-end July, compared to IEEE membership being down 20,491 or 5.5%, for the same timeframe. Meanwhile Society membership, without Affiliates, is also down 3,804, or 1.3%. Month-end June Society membership (including Affiliates) was down 2.0% and therefore it appears the rate of membership decline continues to improve in July and move closer to 2018 metrics.

Recovery and New Memberships Begin Improvement

While March, April, and May witnessed a decline in the number of recovery, new memberships, and reinstatements resulting from the global pandemic, June and July recovery, new memberships, and reinstatements are seeing a lift with 1,737 more memberships in June and July 2020 compared to the same time period in 2019, or an increase of 12.4%.



Five Societies Grow Membership

Five Societies grew their membership by more than 3% as of July month-end when compared to the same time period last year. Overall gains as of July 2020 month-end is 5,766 in aggregate.







