He has been involved with structure analysis, software development and systems engineering for over 30 years. He participated in the development of version 2.0 of the C4ISR Architecture Framework as part of the development of the Defense Airborne Reconnaissance Office (DARO) Vision Architecture. He also participated in the development of the Financial Management Enterprise Architecture (FMEA), now the Business Enterprise Architecture (BEA). Dr. Dam also supported the development of the Net-Centric Enterprise Services (NCES) architecture for the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA). He currently is working to apply the Framework to various DoD architecture projects using the new DoD Architecture Framework.

Dr. Dam is the author of the book, “*DoD Architecture Framework: A Guide to Applying System Engineering to Develop Integrated, Executable Architectures.*”
