Elements of good design

- Planning
 - Intended audience
 - Message to be communicated
 - Similar messages communicated by your competitors



Coherence

- Design
 - Is a means of communication
 - Not a decoration
 - Importance ideas
 - More prominent
 - Secondary ideas
 - Less prominent



Proportion

Relative size to surrounding objects

- Spacing
 - Headlines
 - White space separation
 - Lines
 - Text
 - Boarders



Contrast

Light and dark areas

Text, artwork and white space

High contrast is good to have

Avoid low contrast



- Uniformity versus Consistency
 - Uniformity leads to boredom
 - Tension is good
 - Good design handles diversity in a consistent way
 - Consistency leads to style




- Page to Page consistency
 - Same margins
 - Identical
 - Typeface, type size, line spacing
 - Body, headlines, subheading and captions
 - Uniform
 - Paragraph indents and spacing between columns
 - Repeating Graphical Elements




Restraint

- Graphic design should be invisible
- Unnecessary emphasis weakens total impact
- Restrict changes
 - Typeface
 - Type size



 Web page design is similar to graphic page design for desktop publishing



If it is hard to use....

Don't make the user think

- Get rid of the questions
 - Obvious vs. requires thought
- Self evident
 - Or at least self explanatory



- How are web sites really used
 - People don't read
 - They scan
 - People don't choose the best option
 - Choose the first option
 - People muddle through
 - Read directions, are you kidding?



Create a hierarchy

Most important is prominent

Relate items visually


Nest related items together



- Conventions
 - Don't be non conventional
 - Ever use a non conventional web shopping cart?


Break pages into clearly defined areas

Make obvious what is clickable



Make choices mindless

Omit (needless) words



- Web Navigation
 - Sense of
 - Scale
 - Direction
 - Location
 - Know how to find items
 - Know where to find items
 - Knowing where you are



- Navigation Every Page should have...
 - Site ID
 - Home link
 - Main Sections links
 - Utilities
 - Help, contact info, site map
 - Search
 - Page name
 - You are here indicators
 - Breadcrumbs

- Home Page design (just one more thing)
 - Site identity
 - Site hierarchy
 - Search
 - Teases
 - Timely content
 - Deals
 - Short cuts
 - Registration
 - Establish trust
 - Show me

Welcome blurb



- Design issues
 - Rollovers
 - See one at a time
 - Need to find them
 - Too fast, popup
 - Pull downs
 - Need to find them
 - Hard to scan
 - Use with well known items
 - i.e. list of states

 - Java


- Client browser

 - ASP


Components

 - Can run on a different server


Visual InterDev - Using a HTML editor




DHTML – Dynamic HTML



DHTML - Creating Script




ASP –Creating ASP pages


