
## **Tutorial 2: Joining Working Groups**




Click on MANAGE ACTIVITY PROFILE

## Heading Text of next screen


In the list of Activity Areas below (initially a list of Societies) clicking on (+) will expand the selection into its constituent components as follows from which you may select the Technical Activity Areas in which you are interested from either a general interest standpoint or specific technical project in which you wish to be involved and presumably ballot.





From the list click on the + sign next to IEEE STATIONARY BATTERY COMMITTEE




At this point there are two different methods.


 $T\phi$  express interest in a working group you only have to click on the check box next to the working group name.
