

Did you know that <u>Technical Ability</u> ranks LAST in importance of leadership effectiveness?



Constructive Relationship Building, defined as caring, showing interest, fairness, and demonstrating is understanding, the key reason for leader effectiveness. Success and failure are primarily tied to relationships among team members, communications between leaders and team members. In contrast, Technical Ability ranks last in importance of leader effectiveness, based on the research by Roger R. Pearman, Ed.D.
