The On-Line d-Dimensional Dictionary Problem and It's Applications

Abstract: The on-line d-dimensional dictionary problem consists of executing on-line any sequence of operations of the form: INSERT(p), DELETE(p) and MEMBERSHIP(p), where p is any point in d-space. The set of points is represented by a new generalization of balanced binary search trees, called d-dimensional balanced binary search trees. We show that any of the above operations can be implemented to take O(d + log n) time, where n is the current number of points in the set, and both INSERT and DELETE operations require no more than a constant number of rotations. We also discuss applications of the d-dimensional dictionary problems that arise when developing efficient approximation algorithms for the problem of covering a set of d-dimensional points with hyperrectangles.

Minimum Edge Length Partitions

Abstract: Given a set P of points that lie inside a rectangle R in the plane, we study the problem of partitioning R into rectangles by introducing a set of orthogonal line segments whose total length is the least possible. In a valid rectangular partition, each point in P must be included in at least one partitioning line segment. Since this problem is NP-hard and thus likely to be computationally intractable, we present several approximation algorithms for its solution. This partitioning problem has applications in the channel definition phase of CAD systems. We also discuss a generalization of the partitioning problem to the multidimensional case and show that some of our algorithms can be easily adapted to solve this more general problem.




