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Swing Trading

• Swing trading is a speculative activity in financial markets where a tradable asset is held for between one to several days in an effort to profit from price changes or 'swings'. A swing trading position is typically held longer than a day trading position, but shorter than buy and hold investment strategies that can be held for months or years. Profits can be sought by either buying an asset or short selling.

Momentum Trading

- An investment strategy that aims to capitalize on the continuance of existing trends in the market. The momentum investor believes that large increases in the price of a security will be followed by additional gains and vice versa for declining values.
- Following the general direction of a market or of the price of an asset.
 Trends can vary in length from short, to intermediate, to long term. If you can identify a trend, it can be highly profitable, because you will be able to trade with the trend.

• Investors have a knack for piling into investments at the top and selling at the bottom. Many investors get caught up in media hype or fear and buy or sell investments at the peaks and valleys of the cycle.

You know you are an emotional investor if:

- You sell your stock if it falls a few cents. You are fixated on stock news. You celebrate unrealized profit.
- You fear stock updates.
- You panic about bad news.
- You make frequent calls to your broker.
- You mourn unrealized loss.

Stop Loss Order

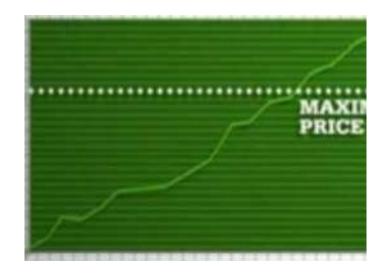
An order placed with a broker to sell a security when it reaches a certain price. A stop-loss order is designed to limit an investor's loss on a position in

a security.



Limit Order

 An order placed with a brokerage to buy or sell a set number of shares at a specified price or better. Because the limit order is not a market order, it may not be executed if the price set by the investor cannot be met during the period of time in which the order is left open.

Trailing Stop loss

A stop order that can be set at a defined percentage away from a security's current market price. A trailing stop for a long position would be set below the security's current market price; for a short position, it would be set above the current price. A trailing stop is designed to protect gains by enabling a trade to remain open and continue to profit as long as the price is moving in the right direction, but closing the trade if the price changes direction by a specified percentage.

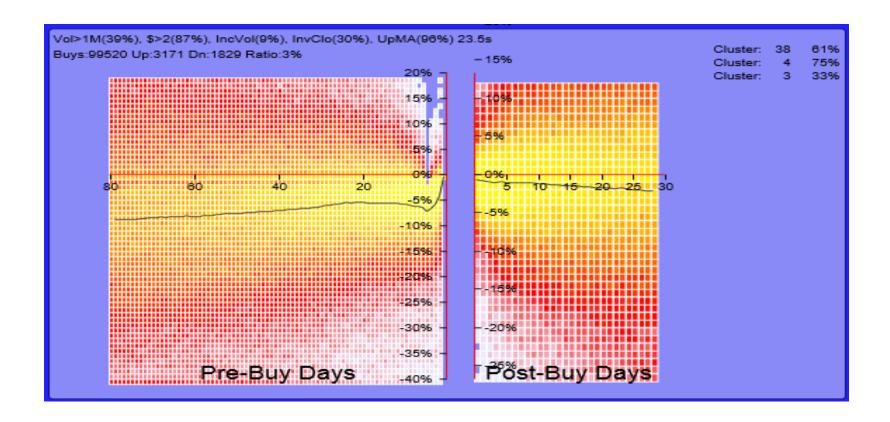

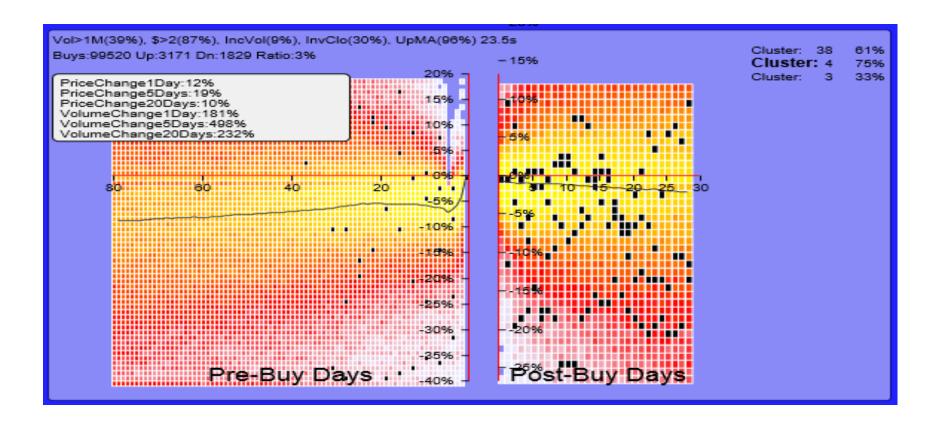

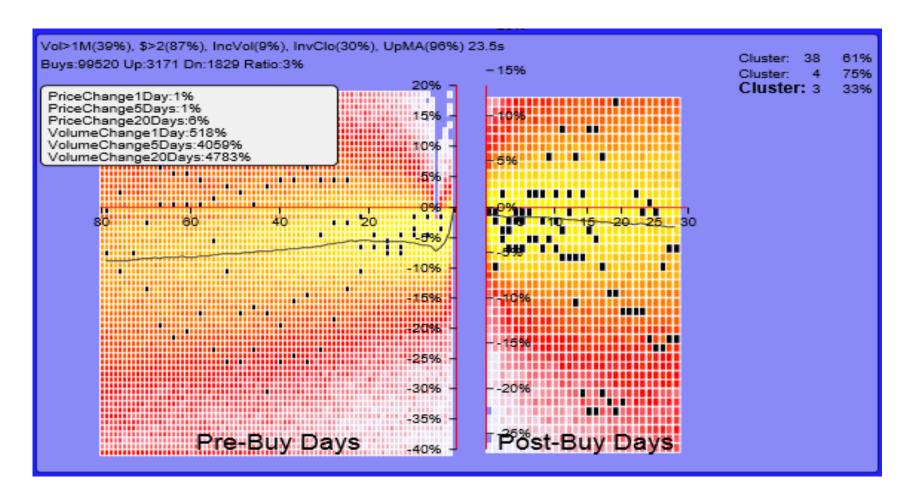
Testing and Tuning – Time Series Heat Map

Investopedia: Aroon Indicator

The indicator reports the time it is taking for the price to reach, from a starting point, the highest and lowest points over a given time period, each reported as a percentage of total time.

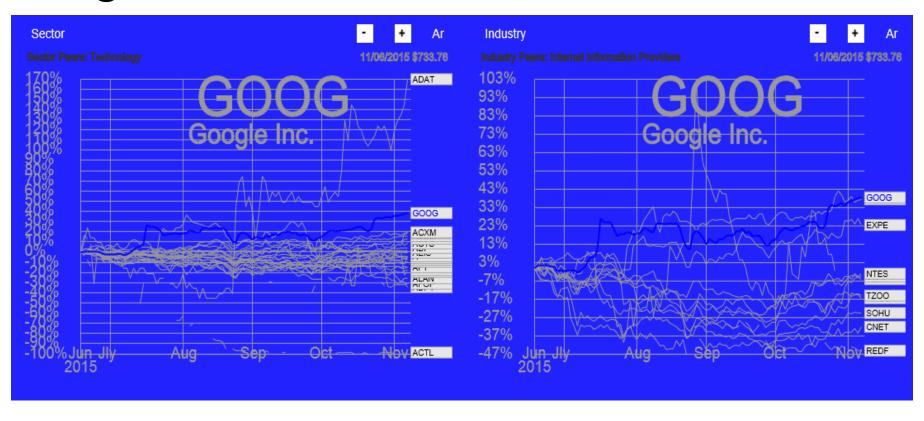

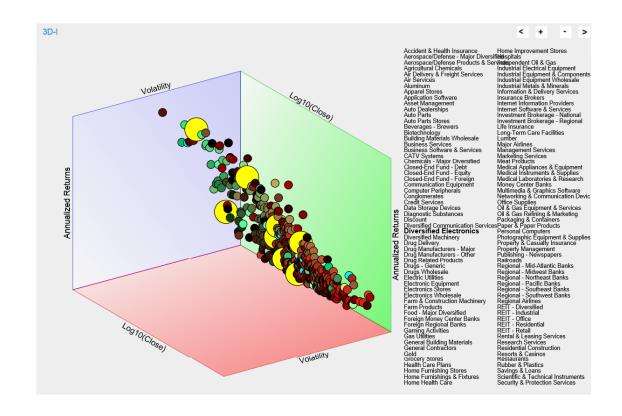
