#### **Reliability Society:**

Mike Silverman gave the presentation. They hold their meetings on the last Wednesday of every month at HP Oak room. They have a joint meeting with CPMT, ASQ and SRE. No summer meetings. Members are 500-600. About 20-30 people attend the meeting. They have \$4783 with IEEE CBRS account.

#### Stanford University:

Gary Chang and Vincent Mei presented the results. They meet every 2-3 weeks and about 30 people attend the meetings. They have a total of 2445 members (F 126, LF 19, SM 311, M 1657, Grad Students 236, Undergrad students 39). They have a three pronged approach to their activities: Professional, Academics and Community. Grad students mentor undergrad students. They also have an Electrical Engineering and Computer Science Journal (ECJ) where students author papers. They have six faculty members who help Freshmen decide on which area to specialize. They have \$5064 in their bank account. They have a hands-on Electronics for the Academics wing where students build circuits and develop interest in Electronics.
