

# ExCom Meeting Minutes - April 1, 2009

Held at Cogswell College, Sunnyvale, CA

Section Chair Roxsana Hadjizadeh called the meeting to order at 6:06 PM

#### **Agenda**

- Agenda was approved as submitted.
- Last meeting minutes of March 4, 2009 rev-2 by Mohamed Sayed were approved without change.

### **IEEE Engineering Milestone Coordinator – Dick Ahrons**

Roxsana moved Dick's report to the beginning of the meeting.

### • HP-35 Milestone Event

This is set for Tuesday, April 14<sup>th</sup> at 10:30AM. It will be held at HP as an intimate celebration with the HP-35 design team. Roxsana, Dave and Dick will attend representing IEEE-SVS. Lew Terman, 2008 President, will attend as a representative and a speaker for national IEEE.

### • IC@50 Milestone Event

- A granite pedestal (cost \$700) has been ordered and will be installed with the plaque by April 29<sup>th</sup>.
- At the Computer History Museum (CHM) there will be a display of the original Hoerni and Noyce notebooks.
- The May IEEE-SCV Section meeting is changed from Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday, May 5<sup>th</sup>.
- This celebration will be held on two dates: Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> and Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup>. IEEE has an allocation of 20 VIP tickets and 80 general admission tickets for each evening. The 20 VIP tickets will be administered by Roxsana, Allen, Tom, and Dick. The 80 general admission tickets will be administered by Kris Verma and David Craven.
- The two evening sessions will be video recorded. Dick will be getting copies of all of the video records on DVD.
- Media (newspapers, TV, radio) will be invited to the Computer History Museum on Thursday May 7<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Chapter Reports**

 Reliability Chapter, Stanford University Chapter and University of California at Santa Cruz Chapter were not present at this meeting. Their reports will be rescheduled to a future meeting.



### • San Jose State University Chapter

- SJSU Chapter Chair Srinivas Muddagown introduced chapter officers as follows: Vice Chair – Jeremy Eades; Treasurer - Ema Imeraj; Public Relations-Mona Fahimi; Webmaster - Doug Decker and Membership Activities - Reuben Thibodeau.
- For Spring 2009, there were 164 student members, 100 undergraduates and 64 graduates.
- Ema presented the finances. The Current Balance is \$5,219 and Source of Incomes are Snack Shop, Shirts, Speaker Donations, texts, manuals and lab kits. Fixed Cost Expenses are about \$359.
- Doug presented the website information. Also available resources and membership benefits were presented.
- Mona presented the activities for Fall 2008 which included Industry Talks, Movies Night, Flag Football, Pizza Night, Welcome Back BBQ, Recruiting Booth, Professor Talks at Spartan Preview Day.
- o Activities for Spring 2009 and SJSU Chapter goals were presented by Srinivas.
- Reuben Thibodeau presented future IEEE-SJSU endeavors which included increased student membership participation.
- Dave Craven moved to donate \$400 to the SJSU Chapter and Mohamed Sayed seconded it. The motion was approved unanimously. Mark wrote the check for the \$400 donation and \$300 budgeted for the SJSU Chapter for a total of \$700.

### Nanotechnology Council

- Nick Massetti, Council Chair presented the report. Council mission and activities were presented.
- Ten monthly noon hour educational seminars and networking events with industry speakers were planned for the third Tuesday of the month. A full day symposium is planned for May, and half day symposium in November. The average event attendance is 43 IEEE members and 18 non-IEEE members. The Council ListServ has 800 addresses.
- Corporate Sponsors are IBM, Semi, HP, Hitachi, National SC, SRI, Agilent and six other sponsors.
- o The budget for 2009 is \$13,644.
- The 2009 Symposium budget ranges from low (85 attendees, net \$900) to nominal (100 attendees and net \$1,370) to high (115 attendees and net \$2,035).

#### • Santa Clara University Chapter

- The report was presented by Chapter Vice Chair Rich Navarro; Treasurer -Sean Schiff and Secretary - Curtis Wong.
- o Membership is 10, and active members are 20-30.
- The budget started with \$2,000 plus \$900 from the EE Department. At the present time, the Chapter Budget is \$2,500.
- The activities list for Fall 2008 included: EE Time meetings, company recruitments, EDS Colloquium and Department gatherings.
- The activities list for Winter and Spring 2009 were presented. The list included EE Times, social events, Techbridge Girl Scout Outreach, Field Trips to Cisco



- Systems, Patent Law Guest Speaker, Physics, Math and Science Days, and End of the Year BBQ.
- Roger Hoyt moved to donate \$400 to the SCU Chapter and Mohamed Sayed seconded it. The motion was approved unanimously. Mark wrote the check for \$400 donation and \$300 budgeted to the Chapter, for a total of \$700.

### Power Electronics Society

- o Greg Fountain, Vice Chair, gave the presentation.
- The new PELS website is now online.
- o Current funds are \$3,566.71 as of January 31, 2009.
- o A list of 2008 and 2009 speakers was presented.
- Objectives for 2009 are: have more than 100 attendees per month, 2 seminars per year, increase cash flow, and focus on new power electronics.
- The new meeting location is National Semiconductor, Building E. Meetings are typically held the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month from 6:00-9:00 PM.
- o PELS total membership is 723, including 424 members in SCV.

# o IEEE 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration Report − Ram

There was a lot of progress made last month. HQ donated \$8,000 to SCV Section. The celebration date will be September 16<sup>th</sup> and the number of expected guests will be changed from 250 to 350. Three Bay Area sections will invite 300 quests for the September 16<sup>th</sup> event.

### o EMC budget request for the mini-symposium event - Oscar Mahi Fallah

- The last International EMC Symposium in the Bay Area was held in 2004. The EMC Chapter proposed to hold a 2 day mini-symposium on Thursday and Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. The cost for attending this mini-symposium will be \$195 for IEEE members and \$350 for non-IEEE members. There is an estimated attendance of 40 people, and revenue will be ~\$11,000. The estimate of expenses is \$11,375. The EMC Chapter is requesting a non-refundable \$8,000 donation from SCV Section to continue developing this mini-symposium.
- After a lively discussion for 12 minutes, it was decided that Oscar will come back next month with more details regarding expenses and a request which will include most of the input from ExCom members.

#### Co-Sponsor Event for Publicity – Communications Society – Bin

- Professor Henning Schulzrinne, Chair of the Department of Computer Science at Columbia University, will be coming to the Bay Area and will give a lecture on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Bin would like to get as many co-sponsors for this event as possible. Bin e-mailed a notice to the e-Grid. Roxsana asked Bin to e-mail the event information to ExCom and Chapter Chairs to let their membership know about the event.

  - A table comparing Performance against Planned Cost was presented, as well as the rest of the plans for 2009.

    - SCV-ComSoc Chapter submitted a milestone request to Robert Colburn and received an approval on October 14, 2008. It seems that the SCV and SCV-ComSoc proposals are very similar.
