- Last meeting minutes of January 7, 2009 rev. 2 were approved without changes.

Chapter Reports

- Circuit and Systems Society (CAS)
 - Mark Hooper, Chapter Chair, presented the report which named chapter officers and the chapter's financial status. The Chapter has 2,739 active members. This includes 52 Fellows, 25 Life Fellows, and 248 Senior Members.
 - A summary of CAS Chapter 2008 activities, technical talks, publications and 2009 plans were presented.

Electromagnetic Compatibility Society (EMCS)

- Ken Renda, Chapter Vice Chair, presented the report which named chapter officers and the chapter's financial status (149 members).
- The EMCS Chapter invited students in early January from the SCV Section and offered to sponsor the first 25 students for IEEE membership. Unfortunately, no students showed up. It was suggested to invite the students in October or November to get a better response.

Engineering in Medicine and Biology Society (EMBS)

 Ken Doniger, Chapter Webmaster, presented the report which named chapter officers and the chapter's financial status. An average of 40 members attend monthly chapter technical meetings.



Officer Reports

Chair Reports – Roxsana Hadjizadeh

- ExCom members were asked to come up with ideas to help increase our section membership. CNSV (Ken Parnell and John Gale) presented ideas for helping our members during a recession.
- CNSV requested seed money of \$20K to use for sponsoring seminars and workshops for our members. Details for this program will be presented within 30-60 days.
- The three representatives for SFBAC are:
 - Ram Sivaraman (secretary),
 - Tom Coughlin (first delegate) and
 - Fred Jones (second delegate).
- The Central Area Spring Meeting was announced by Tom Coughlin. This
 meeting will be an all day event at UC Santa Cruz on March 28th.
- A report on the IEEE 125th Anniversary Celebration was given by Ram Sivaraman. It will be held on September 16, 2009 from 6:00-9:00 PM at the San Jose DoubleTree Hotel. About 400 people are expected to attend this activity. Hors d'oeuvres will be served. It was moved by Tom Coughlin and seconded by Dick Ahrons to allocate \$8,100 from the SCV Section for this celebration. The motion was passed unanimously.
- A status report on the 2011 Section Congress to be held in San Francisco was given by Roger Hoyt. The date will be August 19-22, 2011.
- 2009 Officers training feedback The training was good and the Section thanks Min Hua for all of his efforts.
- SVEC Engineering Banquet The report from Jack Berg was given earlier in this meeting. 33 members and 14 spouses are signed up to attend. It was moved by Tom Coughlin and seconded by David Craven to buy a fourth table for an additional \$750. The motion was passed unanimously. Roxsana will determine who will be attending from the Section ExCom and Chapter Officers.

• Treasurer Report – Mark Hooper

There were not many activities during January 2009. As of Sunday, February 3rd,
 26 out of 31 chapters submitted L-50 reports. January's budgeted expenditures were \$3,675 and actual expenditures were \$5,891.55.

- HP-35 (Dave Cochran) No progress was made by HP in setting the date for the plaque ceremony. One possible idea is to have it the same week as the IC-50. ExCom members recommended having it at some other time.
- Dick received a bronze plaque that was made to celebrate this milestone. The next step is to design and order the granite pedestal.
- The 8 page color handout is out for bid with Marcelo, who has been slow to respond. We may have to go elsewhere. Min has volunteered to do the graphics for the first page.
- The event is being finalized. Two panelists, one for Bell Labs and one for RCA Labs, have not yet been identified for May 6th. May 8th AM and PM speakers are finalized. Secondary details and PR is in progress. Paul has agreed to give GRID support.
- O ARPA NET Stanford (Tom Coughlin) Tom received an email from Simon Wong of the Stanford EE Department concerning the placement of the milestone plaque. Tom requested that someone else needs to follow through. Mohamed Sayed (parent of a Stanford alumnus) volunteered to take on this task and call/meet with Simon to finalize the situation. Mohamed will be updating the ExCom at the next meeting on March 4th.
