ExCom Meeting Minutes - May 5, 2009

Held at Cogswell College, Sunnyvale, CA

- Agenda was approved as submitted.
- Last meeting minutes of April 1, 2009 rev-1 by Mohamed Sayed were approved without change.

IEEE 125th Anniversary Celebration Report – Ram

 Craig Barrett of Intel was supposed to be the 125th Anniversary Celebration Keynote Speaker. However since he is retiring from Intel by the end of May, he will not be able to deliver the keynote address as an invitee from Intel. Ram has contacted the current CEO of Intel, Paul Otellini and TJ Rogers, CEO of Cypress Semiconductors and Eric Schmidt, CEO of Google. He is yet to hear back from them.

Planning Committee - 9th Annual Expanding Your Horizons (EYH) Conference–Donna Ziel

- The Conference will be held on May 16th at UCSC. 250 young women in grades 8-12, and 25 adults are expected to attend.
- There will be hands-on workshops led by women researchers and professionals in life and physical sciences.
- The fee is \$20 for workshop materials, snack, and lunch.
- Samples of the workshop materials were shown.
- Donna asked for financial support. Dick Ahrons moved to give \$500 to the EYH Conference. Tom Coughlin seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously. Mark wrote a check to Donna Ziel after she filled out the required paper work.



HP-35 Commemoration – Dave Cochran

- Dave gave a check of \$600 to Mark Hooper for this IEEE historical event.
- Planning for the HP-35 Commemoration took 2.5 years to complete. Pictures of Lewis Terman, whose father advised Bill Hewlett and David Packard to start HP company in Palo Alto, were shown.
- Roxsana asked Dave Cochran to label the pictures with the names of people who were in them.
- The pictures and the plaque will be displayed the HP lobby.
