Brian Berg called the meeting to order at 6:02 pm.

## Acceptance of February 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting Minutes (Brian Berg)

Brian asked if there were any objections to acceptance of the minutes from the 1 February 2012 meeting. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted.

#### Acceptance of March 7 Meeting Agenda (Brian Berg)

Brian asked if there were any objections to acceptance of the previously circulated agenda for the 7 March 2012 meeting. Hearing no objections, the agenda was accepted.

## **Central Area Report (Ram Sivaraman)**

- Region 6 Meeting Report (San Diego, 24-25 February)

- SCV applauded for its support of Student groups

  - o The most recent one was the SPICE milestone, which was dedicated in 2011

- Ram explained that IEEE needs to fund their pension account since they are attempting
  to sell it to an investment company, and they hafe had to establish a 15% reserve. \$48K
  of SCV funds have not been withdrawn but are instead locked as part of this process.
- SCV is affected with its 660K\$ in reserve. We would lose the \$48K if they are in fact needed. Any chapter OU that has more than 20K\$ and has a ratio of greater than 200% reserves to expenses is impacted; SCV and its OUs is treated as one OU.
