**Status of all Financially Sponsored Conferences** – Aerospace continues to be a problem. They agreed with IEEE Conference to turn over 100% of this year's surplus but as you can see they are delinquent for 2002 and 2003 so don't count on seeing this for three years at least. Other minor issues: Autotestcon 2005 has not submitted a budget. 21<sup>st</sup> DASC 2002 is very slow at submitting finals – 2003 will probably close first. Radar 2003 has not submitted yet and will probably be fined.
