 - IEEE C37.45, "Standard Specifications for High-Voltage Distribution Class Enclosed Single-Pole Air Switches with Rated Voltages from 1 through 8.3kV," was approved in March, it was the first document inherited from NEMA to be revised and converted to an IEEE document.
 - IEEE C37.42, "Specification for High-Voltage Expulsion Type Distribution Class Fuses, Cutouts, Fuse Disconnecting Switches and Fuse Links," will be balloted soon.
 - Attached is the HVFSC Project Status report to ADSCOM (Att 3).
- III. High Voltage SwitchesAlex Dixon
 - IEEE PC37.30.x combination is out for invitation for WG members.
 - IEEE 1247
 - Recommended to split into two documents
 - The test code should be a WG sponsored by ADSCOM
 - The product code should be a WG sponsored by HVS
 - Request that ADSCOM take over the test code sections
 - HVS will develop the scope and formal vote for this recommendation and request.
 - The scope and purpose in the PAR for PC37.30.1 is not consistent with the document. Discussion indicates that the PAR scope conflicts with IEEE1247. The PAR will need to be changed anyway and the scope can be reviewed at that time.

- C37.17 (Standard for Trip Devices for AC and General Purpose DC LV PCBs) – Currently revision of document is in process.
