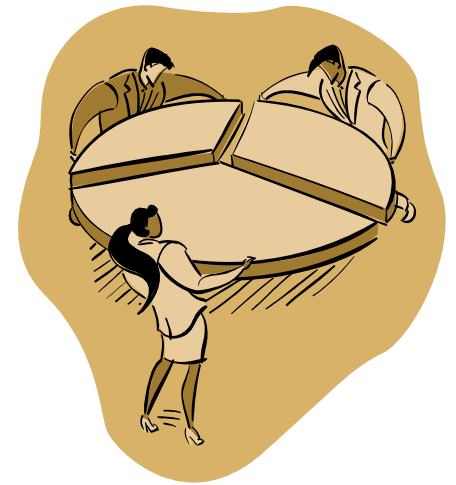

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IEC/IEEE Dual Logo Agreement Three Parts

- Original Agreement
- Maintenance Procedure
- Joint Development Procedure



Original Agreement

- Signed in October 2002
- Allows for the adoption of IEEE standards by IEC, with no change
- Key Points
 - The use of both an IEC and IEEE number is allowed (e.g., IEC 62271-111/IEEE Std C37.60)
 - IEEE retains the copyright
 - The original IEEE standard is republished, with IEC adding the appropriate frontmatter and headers/footers
 - IEEE participant list is moved and placed in the last Annex of the document

Maintenance Procedure

- Developed to address revision of IEEE standards adopted by IEC
- Key Points
 - Once the document is revised both the IEC and IEEE numbers are maintained (e.g., IEC 62271-111/IEEE Std C37.60)
 - IEEE retains the copyright
 - Document may either be kept in the IEEE template or moved into the IEC template
 - Decision is made by the Dual Logo Maintenance Team
 - IEC is responsible for publication
 - Document is submitted to ANSI for accreditation
 - List of IEEE participants placed in the last Annex of the document

Joint Development Procedure

- Developed to allow for joint development between both organizations
 - Applies to new or existing standards
- Key Points
 - The document shall be numbered using an IEC/IEEE 6xxxxx number (common name)
 - Use of 62271-37-xxx is possible
 - Since IEC 62271 includes the use of “High-Voltage Switchgear and Controlgear – Part xxx:”, this needs to be part of the title
 - Copyright is shared by both organizations
 - Document shall be placed in the IEC template
 - IEC responsible for publication
 - Document submitted to ANSI for accreditation
 - Participant list is placed on a website, the URL of which is included in the frontmatter of the document

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
