The STLNA group met on the evening of 28 September 2010.

- STLNA hosted the STL Management Committee (STL MC) at conclusion of the IEEE Switchgear meeting in Myrtle Beach and Kirk Smith presided as chair of the STL MC Meeting. Highlights:
 - The STLA, STL Agreement Group was disbanded. STLA dealt with only European activities and STL is now international and STLA no longer had a good purpose.
 - The committee reviewed site visits for a lab in Korea and China for possible admission as full members to STL
- STLNA compared some aspects of the constitutions of STL and STLNA and agreed to review possible revisions to the STLNA constitution.
- STLNA is looking at issues regarding X/R ratios; minimum values and maximum values such that the peak current is within 5% of the rated value. We will make a decision via e-mail correspondence and we will propose indicated actions.
- Two new labs are in the process of joining STLNA

 - CEPEL of Brazil
