Observations and Concerns

- Terms with multiple definitions
 - harmonized where possible
- Similar terms
 - harmonized where possible
 - ex.: "ambient temperature" and "ambient air temperature"
- Many long definitions
 - try <u>hard</u> to limit to one sentence
- Terms with "rated" should be avoided
 - ex.: Define the term "continuous current" but
 - place "rated continuous current" in the rating clause as a value, not a term.
