Possible conversions of metal-enclosed interrupter switchgear include:

- a) addition of fuses to equipment not originally designed to have power fuses substitution of power fuses of a different type or rating than that for which the equipment was designed,
- b) replacing fuses with a stationary circuit breaker,
- c) replacing load break switch and fuse combination with a stationary circuit breaker,
- d) replacing a load break switch and fuse combination with a drawout circuit breaker, or
- e) replacing a non-load break switch with a drawout circuit breaker. All of these conversions require design verification.
