Comment resolution during the meeting disposed of all 28 Comments. Particular points discussed during comment resolution included:

- One set of comments suggested the removal of specification of the frequency of the inrush current on capacitive switching. The WG agreed with the intent of the comments by a vote of the WG members present 8 to 3 (2 not voting).
- In order to avoid duplication of definitions within the online dictionary some definitions were removed, other terms that need not be raised to the level of definitions were relocated to other parts of the document.
- The IEEE editors called into question the use of the word "shall" in this guide, which was intended to be used only in an exemplary fashion (i.e. proposed wording to be used in the specification). In response each use of the word "shall" was reviewed by the WG as a whole. The majority of uses were confirmed as appropriate as examples of proposed wording, however five uses of 'shall' were changed.

The existing comment resolution group (CRG) formed from the prior meeting was authorized to continue work. Tasked to implement the agreed upon changes in the draft and recirculate the ballot if needed. Motion made by Andy Keels, Seconded by Mike Skidmore. Approved by voice vote.
