Global Update

India

- Telecom Centers of Excellence (TCOE)
 - MoU signed 24 February 2014
 - Deliver carrier-grade WiFi® (IEEE 802.11™) certification for India

China

- Workshop with Academia, hosted by Tsinghua University
 - Held Saturday, 15 March 2014
 - Tsinghua University interested in 802.11, 802.15, 802.16, 802.19, 802.21, 802.22 and 802.24
 - Other universities in Beijing invited to attend
 - Audience was expected to be primarily Master/PhD students, with some faculties/researchers
- IEEE 802 University Outreach Program in Beijing, China during the March 2014 IEEE 802 Plenary

Europe

- Europe Office coordinating with 802.18 on Spectrum issues in Europe
- European Multi-Stakeholder Platform for ICT Standardisation (MSP) Updates
 - Significance: MSP advises the European Commission on ICT standardization-related items
 - European Commission worked with MSP to develop the "EU Rolling Plan for ICT Standardisation". It provides an overview of key European policy needs and maps relevant ongoing standardization activities and identifies potential needs to support the policies.
