■ India

- As part of the IEEE-SASB outreach activities, Jon Rosdahl attended Jamia Millia University and gave an overview of IEEE 802 standards to students

■ Germany

- As part of the IEEE-SA BoG outreach activities, IEEE-SA gave a lecture to masters students in the Strategic Standardization course at the Technische Universität Berlin on "IEEE and the power of technology standards to transform the world---Introducing the case of IEEE 802 standards"
 - Konstantinos Karachalios presented on "The power of technology standards to transform the world"
 - Dorothy Stanley presented on "Current trends in WLAN and/or wireless 802 standards"
 - David Law presented on "Current trends in Ethernet and/or wired 802 standards"
 - Approximately 20 students attended
 - Questions were asked relating to standards and smart textiles, whether standardization is fast enough to meet market need, and at the more technical level relating to 802 and LTE

Outreach in Asia (2)

- Japan
 - As part of the IEEE-SA CAG outreach activities, IEEE-SA, IEEE Japan Council, and 5G Mobile Forum (5GMF) jointly hosted a 5G workshop in Tokyo
 - More than 100 attendees participated
 - Glenn Parsons and Hiroshi Mano gave presentations related to 802
 - Glenn gave a shorter version of the 5G presentation to both the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications (MIC) and ARIB
 - MIC and some other companies asked questions related to spectrum harmonization in 802.18
