Activities since July 2017

■ South America

- Ecuadorian Service for Standardization (INEN)
 - IEEE signed an adoption/translation agreement with INEN earlier this year
 - First such agreement for IEEE-SA in South America
 - Shared 802 overview presentation with INEN staff as part of training on IEEE-SA's adoptions process
 - Goal - highlight potential standards for adoption as Ecuadorian national standards

■ Oceania

- Australia
 - IEEE-SA hosted a Standards Education event at the University of Melbourne
 - Andrew Myles gave an introduction to IEEE 802
 - James Irvine spoke about the IEEE 5G initiative efforts
 - IEEE-SA IoT Industry Workshop
 - Andrew Myles spoke on IEEE 802 and its impact on IoT

Activities since July 2017 (2)

■ Europe

- Attended a workshop on 'ICT Standards' at ITC (International Teletraffic Congress) in Genoa, Italy
 - Provided information about IEEE, IEEE-SA, the challenge of autonomous systems and IEEE-SA's standards activities for automotive (including IEEE 802.1, 802.3ch and IEEE 802.11p)

■ Webinar - “The Next Generation of Standards” for the Engineering for Change community

- Highlighted IEEE 802.22 TV WhiteSpace standard, in addition to low-voltage DC microgrids for remote areas and other relevant standards

IEEE Sections Congress

- SA had a full program of activities at IEEE Sections Congress in Australia
- Items related to IEEE 802
 - Short (1/2 hour) session
 - Why Do Standards Matter? (presented by Andrew Myles, Don Wright, and Mary Lynne Nielsen)
 - 1 long (1 hour) session
 - How Standards Can Increase Member Engagement (presented by Don Wright, David Law, Andrew Myles, and Mary Lynne Nielsen)
- 802 activities were in highlighted many of these presentations
 - Both as highly influential industry program and as example of technology benefiting humanity
 - David Law and Andrew Myles, as speakers from 802, were able to speak from their personal experiences
