On 03 November 2017 I received a draft IEEE Standards Association position statement on Spectrum via email from Karen McCabe. It was assigned to the IEEE 802.18 Radio Regulatory Technical Advisory Group (RR-TAG) for review. The 802.18 RR-TAG reviewed the document during the IEEE 802 LAN/MAN Standards Committee (LMSC) 05-10 November 2017 plenary session held in Orlando FL. Upon thorough review by 802 LMSC's regulatory experts, the RR-TAG created an edited and commented version of the document, it is available at https://mentor.ieee.org/802.18/dcn/17/18-17-0131-04-0000-ieee-sa-additional-spectrum-needed-position-statement.docx.

The 802.18 RR-TAG experts approved (15 yes, 1 no, 1 abstain) submission of the above version to the IEEE 802 LMSC Executive Committee (LMSC-EC) for review/approval. The LMSC-EC unanimously approved submitting the 18-17-0131-04 document to the IEEE Standards Association Strategic Planning Coordination Committee (SA-SPCC) as the IEEE 802 LMSC Sponsor input to the draft position statement.
