## 'Deadbeat' status update

- Collections have been largely successful
  - 14 at start of session, now 7
    - 5 paid, 2 removed for errors (1 duplicate email, 1 left meeting at payment notice)
- List emailed to WG chairs, updated
- Individuals notified of sanctions under rules and pending posting

### Considerations leading to proposal

- All bear responsibility for the continued functioning of IEEE 802
  - Expenses could be individually allocated, but all benefit from greater participation and more personal interaction
    - Fairness can be argued both ways on whether in-person or remote should pay more
    - This is not about cookies at the hotel, or the remote feed it is about our shared goal of producing high-quality, market-relevant, consensus standards
  - Managing separate registration fees and separate expenses would increase complexity of the meeting without materially changing the financial picture
- Due to uncertainty and financial stress, March 2022 fees have to be commensurate with the meeting expenses
  - A significant (6 digit) loss would be problematic

#### Recommended fees on March 2022 meeting

- Proposed Fee structure has same fee whether in-person/at the hotel, or remote/not at the hotel
  - Allows budget for remote participation budget at expected levels
- Proposed fee structure: (designed for break even at 700 participants)
  - \$700 until Friday, January 28, 2022 (fully refundable)
  - \$850 until Friday, February 25, 2022 (refundable with cancellation fee)
  - \$1000 after Friday, February 25, 2022 (non-refundable)
