# 802 Electronic Media 2022 Update

- IEEE 802 Electronic Media 2022 Edition – 982 MB
  - Includes all published standards as of 01 Jan 2022
- The process of obtaining the link will be different but the same distribution method (iMeet Central) will be used
- Once an 802 Plenary ends, the Executive Secretary will provide a list of those that have registered for the meeting to IEEE SA Staff
  - The list will include email address and SA PIN
    - SA PIN is required for registration

- IEEE SA Staff will upload the list to mentor
- An email will be sent to the individuals that registered for the IEEE 802 March Plenary, inviting them to download the IEEE 802 2022 Standards Collection after registration has closed for the 802 Plenary
- Individuals will be provided a link to mentor
  - Individuals will need to agree to terms of license agreement
  - Individuals will have one week to download the file
- The same process will be followed for future 2022 802 plenaries
- NOTE: There will be no physical media available for 2022
