

# Comment

- Comment Category: Editorial Must be satisfied: Yes
- Page #: 65, Subclause: A, Line #: 7
- Comment:
  - The text referencing Bibliographic Entry [B1] has been removed as per a prior Disapprove MBS Comment, but the entry itself has not been removed. Bibliographic entries that are not referenced must be removed. These include {B1}, [B9], and [B10].
- Proposed Change:
  - Remove [B1] from the Bibliography, and other unreferenced entries as per comment.

# Options/comments

- Comment: The style manual does not require removing unreferenced bibliography entries
- Options:
  - Accept the comment (or revised) and recirculate again
  - Reject the comment as out of scope and go to RevCom
  - Reject comment (other reason) and recirculate unchanged draft
  - Others?
- Deadline for December RevCom: 21 October 2024
  - Recirculation could start 10 October 2024, end 20 October 2024
  - AFAIK: Can submit to RevCom as long as recirculation finishes prior to RevCom meeting.

# Resolution

- Rejected. The comment is out of scope as it is not a comment on a changed portion of the draft. Refer this change to IEEE SA Editorial staff for consideration during preparation for publication.
