Questions and discussion: Presenter is asked if the UWB implementation in the iPhone 11 is based on 802,15.4z. Answer: yes, based on the draft standard. A question is asked regarding standardization of the higher layers (above the MAC). The presenter is unable to answer at this time.

Questions and discussion: Discussion ensues regarding the organization of 802.15.4 and possibly created a new standard focused on UWB. Several perspectives are presented with consensus reached hat this is an idea worth consideration. It is suggested to discuss further after the last technical presentation.

Further discussion

Lively discussion follows. Interest is expressed in perusing additional enhancements for UWB in the framework of 802.15 standards. Also, the concept of a UWB focused 802.15 standard which builds upon 802.15.4 is discussed. Many views are expressed to support potential restricting 802.15.4 as well as support for next generation UWB. Consensus is reached that there are two areas for further consideration, and thus it is suggested to initiate two Interest Groups in Working Group 802.15:

- 1. Create an interest group for next generation UWB
- 2. Create an interest group for 802.15.4 structure

It is noted by the Working Group chair that Interest Groups are formed by the Working Group chair. Having heard sufficient consensus to proceed, the Working Group chair says "make it so".

WNG Chair (Benjamin Rolfe) volunteers to chair both interest groups to get things started. Hearing no other volunteers, the WG chair so appoints.

Discussion of next steps

The group consensus is to begin Interest Group ad-hoc meetings prior to the January virtual interim meeting. The WNG chair takes the action to initiate IG ad-hoc calls following the November plenary closes.

Any Other Business

The next WNG meeting will be during the January 2020 wireless interim (virtual). Reminder is given to make requests for WNG time with the WNG chair.
