The IEEE 802.16 Working Group (WG) on Broadband Wireless Access is writing to provide an update on our progress on amending IEEE Std 802.16-2012 for enhancements to better address Small Cell Backhaul (SCB) Applications, and to seek your views.

The WG has begun the development of the Architecture and Requirements Document for the <u>802.16r project</u> on <u>Small Cell Backhaul</u>.

The Working Group is aware of the creation of a new Backhaul SIG within the Small Cell Forum, and we would like to encourage cooperation between our organizations to further the development of the IEEE 802.16r project. Our next face-to-face meeting will occur at our <u>Session #88</u> (11-14 Nov 2013 in Dallas, TX, USA), but we plan a <u>set of teleconference meetings</u> in the interim.
