Bangalore Local Transportation

- **Taxis:** Within Bangalore Taxi services are provided by several operators commonly referred to as *Citi taxis* which can carry up to four passengers and are usually metered and more expensive than auto-rickshaws.
- **Autorickshaws:** Three-wheeled, black and yellow auto-rickshaws, referred to as *autos*, are a popular form of transport. They are metered and can accommodate up to three passengers.
- **Buses:** The Bangalore Metropolitan Transport Corporation (BMTC) operates Buses throughout the city. Commuters can buy tickets on boarding these buses. BMTC also runs air-conditioned Volvo buses on major routes.
