# Cellular Comparison White Paper Discussion

# Discussion of Question 236 and related ITU regulatory issues

Mike Lynch updates the group on the progress related to question 236 in Europe. The potential impact on 802 wireless technologies is significant. Mike describes several new issues in ITU that he suggests all 802 wireless groups should review and for which an 802 response is appropriate. Topics include wireless power transmission via beam forming, and potential restrictions on visible light communications. Mike suggests preparation of an 802 response by Sept for EC approval by letter ballot to meet the submission deadline. [See doc # 24-16-0019 for references].
