16 **1. Opening business**

- 17 • IEEE DySPAN-SC started the meeting at 3:15 pm local time, Grenoble, France,
18 on June 25, 2012
- 19 • Chair of the DySPAN-SC (Hiroshi Harada) presided and Secretary of DySPAN-
20 SC (Yohannes Alemseged) presented.
- 21 • The Chair made a brief introduction. Then, he made call for Potentially Essential
22 Patents and indicated patent related links for further information.
- 23 • Attendance of the participants was taken (**Addendum A**). In total 20 participants
24 attended the meeting out of which 18 of them have voting right.
- 25 • As per the previously established membership list, 18 members out of 23 present
26 during the meeting and secretary announced that the quorum to start the meeting
27 has been established.

17 the existing COMSOC-SDB P&Ps with the
18 substitution of DySPAN-SC in the places where ComSoc is referred to as the
19 Sponsor.
- 20 ▪ 1900.X projects are transferred under the DySPAN-SC

21 He added that the 1900.X activities, formerly under SCC41 and recently under
22 DySPAN-SC were under SASB over sighting. He expressed his sincere thanks to
23 the CSDB members for their valuable input and finally their recommendation for
24 DySPAN-SC to become a sponsor. He passed also cordial thanks to the DySPAN-
25 SC officers, WG chairs and to all those who worked hard with perseverance to make
26 DySPAN-SC a sponsor. He appreciated the process as it helped to gather many
27 experiences and lessons that will strengthen the smooth operation of DySPAN-SC
28 as a sponsor.

29 There was a question on the timing of applying the membership rules as DySPAN-
30 SC is to follow the CSDB p&p.

31 The chair responded that DySPAN-SC has been operating under the CSDB p&p so
32 it will continue to do so until DySPAN-SC obtains its own p&p.

12 Lynn Grande, chair of 1900.5 and Max Riegel, raised an issue that the proposed
13 topic can fall under the 1900.5 activities.

14 Chair Hiroshi Harada suggested the discussions to continue and perhaps clarify the
15 overlap between 1900.5 and the new proposal and then the issue can be brought
16 again in the closing plenary for the committee to decide the way forward.

18 **Wednesday 27th of June, 2012 3:15 PM local time**

19 The Chair requested for outcome of any discussion held in 1900.5 with regard to the
20 new project proposal “Spectrum Consumption Modeling”.

21
22 Chair of 1900.5 WG, Lynn Grande, responded that, the issue was discussed in
23 1900.5 WG sessions and in general it was agreed that the topic falls under the broad
24 spectrum of 1900.5. However, deciding to bring the topic under a new Task Group or
25 under an ongoing project is pending to further discussion in the upcoming WG face to
26 face meeting. Detail is included in the 1900.5 closing report.

27 Chair of the DySPAN-SC applauded the progress and requested for the presentation
28 of the remaining agenda for the closing plenary

30 Ad hoc chair of the DySPAN-SC P&P, Bernd Bochow, presented the following

2 changed since DySPAN-SC has become a sponsor and the default p&p should be
3 consistent with the sponsor p&p.

4 Yohannes added that considering the experience gained by the ad hoc group, the ad
5 hoc can start to work on the sponsor p&p in similar fashion to the default p&p and
6 get approval on it. Then the default p&p can follow the same line and that way the
7 consistency can be ensured.

8 Bernd supported the idea and according to him a time line of next October or
9 November will be reasonable to come up with the draft sponsor p&p

10 The chair agreed with this and requested from the participants if there is objection.
11 No objection was seen and the chair recommended the ad hoc group to continue to
12 work on the draft sponsor p&p.

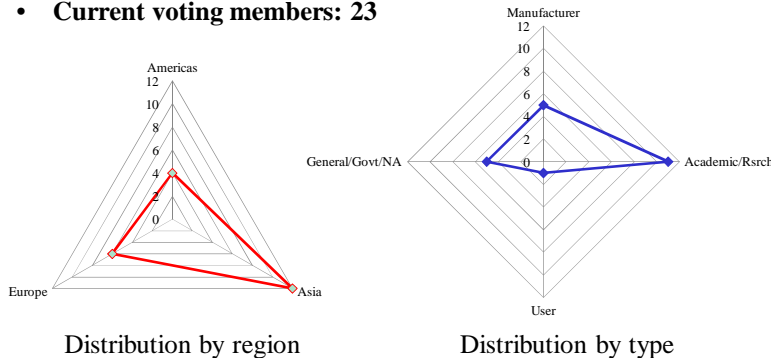
